




DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

The yacht DREAM is a masterpiece of engineering and design, crafted by the renowned German shipyard Abeking & Rasmussen. This full displacement motor yacht, with a hull number of 6430, is a testament to superior craftsmanship and attention to detail. Built in 2001 and refitted in 2023, DREAM boasts a steel hull, an aluminum superstructure, and teak decks, ensuring both durability and elegance. The yacht is powered by two Caterpillar 3516B engines, each delivering 1,400 kW (1,877 Hp), allowing it to reach a maximum speed of 16 knots and a cruising speed of 14 knots. With a fuel consumption of 378 liters per hour at 12 knots, DREAM offers an impressive range of 5,000 nautical miles.

DREAM's dimensions are equally impressive, with a length overall (LOA) of 60.00 meters (196'10"), a beam of 10.70 meters (35'1"), and a draft of 3.50 meters (11'6"). The yacht's gross tonnage is 1,092, and it displaces approximately 920 tons. Accommodations are luxurious and versatile, with the capacity to host up to 16 guests in 7+2 cabins, including a magnificent owner's apartment on the main deck. This apartment features three separate rooms, three bathrooms, and an entrance lobby, with a full-beam bedroom, an onyx master bath, and his and hers walk-in closets. Additional guest cabins are located on the bridge and lower decks, offering a variety of configurations to suit any need.

The yacht's interior, designed by Bannenberg & Rowell, is an elegant blend of precious woods, onyx, and marble, complemented by European custom furniture and Asian artwork. The exterior design by Donald Starkey Designs adds to the yacht's sophisticated allure. DREAM is equipped with state-of-the-art entertainment systems, including a 262 cm/103" cinema in the

sky lounge, a Plex movie server with over 3,000 titles, and surround sound in key areas. The yacht also features a fully equipped gym, a spacious sundeck with a six-person jacuzzi, and a bar.

DREAM's mechanical and navigation equipment is top-tier, featuring Quantum Zero Speed stabilizers, a Schottel bow thruster, and a comprehensive suite of Furuno navigation instruments. Communication is seamless with high-speed internet provided by two Starlink Marine antennas and a range of VHF and satellite communication systems. The yacht's deck equipment includes Steen anchor windlasses, a G&S rescue boat crane, and a custom swimming platform.

For those seeking adventure, DREAM offers an array of tenders and watersports equipment, including a 10m Intrepid tender, a 7.30m Novurania Beachlander tender, Yamaha Waverunners, SeaBobs, and a variety of diving and snorkeling gear. The yacht's refit and maintenance history is extensive, with significant upgrades in both interior and exterior features, ensuring that DREAM remains at the forefront of luxury yachting.

In summary, DREAM is a sophisticated, comfortable, and quiet superyacht, capable of crossing oceans and exploring remote islands with ease. Its award-winning interior, solid German engineering, and continuous upgrades make it a proven charter yacht and a dream come true for any discerning owner.
