## OVERVIEW

The 1999 Boston Whaler Ventura 20' presents a graceful union of practicality and pedigree, a dual console/center console style sportboat that carries the builder's famed unsinkable construction into a family friendly, performance minded package. Poised and durable, with a famously soft ride, this Ventura is equally at home pursuing stripers and bluefish, running the coast for a day of cruising, or towing skis and tubes for watersports—the kind of adaptable dayboat that answers confidently to the needs of anglers and families alike.

Its deck layout emphasizes space and sensible storage, with plentiful seating and dedicated lockers: under seat bins and bow compartments sized to stow tackle, docklines, and gear without cluttering the cockpit. The open, uncluttered working area encourages easy movement, and a well appointed transom supports fishing setups or convenient reboarding from the water. The bowrider configuration and secure walkthrough balance comfort with functionality, enabling inshore exploration or light offshore passages with composure and ease.

Typically driven by a single outboard, the Ventura delivers crisp throttle response and efficient cruising manners. This example is powered by a single Mercury OptiMax 200 HP outboard; the motor has not been run or evaluated, and due to its age routine preventative servicing should be anticipated before operation, as is common for vessels of this era. The boat's rugged build and Boston Whaler lineage make the 1999 Ventura a confident, trailerable center/dual console platform, offering safety, sensible utility, and lasting value to an owner thoughtful about maintenance and electronics fit out.

Cosmetically the vessel presents well for her years and shows considerable upside; a comprehensive interior and exterior detailing will significantly

improve her on water appearance. Seat cushions display wear and may warrant reupholstery or replacement depending on buyer standards. This is a sensible project opportunity: a fundamentally sound hull and systems layout offered at an attractive entry point, particularly for buyers who already possess a trailer, as no trailer is included and none is presently available. With modest attention and routine servicing, she is well positioned to be a standout when the coming season arrives.






