OVERVIEW

Meticulously Rebuilt 1972 Cuda Craft 21 by Ray Bond

This timeless Cuda Craft 21, crafted in 1972 and restored with care by Ray Bond, has been thoughtfully rebuilt to combine classic lines with reliable modern performance. Propulsion comes from a 2015 Yamaha 200 HP outboard displaying just 150 hours, while navigation and situational awareness are handled by a Garmin 7610SXV GPS/Radar unit. Comfort and shade are provided by a fitted canvas sun top, and the hull benefits from fresh bottom paint applied during the refit. An aluminum float-on, dual-axle bunk trailer accompanies the boat, refurbished in 2024 with new axles, springs, and tires for dependable road transport. This restored center console/bay boat remains trailerable, is delivered turn-key, and awaits carefree dayboating adventures.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Notable upgrades

Thoughtfully refined for turnkey confidence, this boat benefits from a Garmin 7610 SXV GPS with radar for crisp, chart accurate awareness, a durable canvas top that extends shade and protection, and dual batteries installed in 2024 to deliver reliable starts and balanced power management; an aluminum bunk trailer was comprehensively upgraded in 2024 for smooth, secure transport, and the hull wears fresh bottom paint for clean, efficient running and enduring performance.

Power & performance

Propelled by a 2015 Yamaha F200XCA rated at 200 HP, this four stroke with smooth fly by wire controls delivers precise throttle response and refined manners underway; showing just 150 hours, it turns a three blade stainless prop for efficient bite across the rev range, while Lenco trim tabs let you fine tune running attitude for confident acceleration, level handling, and an effortless, composed ride.

Electronics & navigation

At the helm, a Garmin 7610 SXV GPS anchors a capable suite, paired with a Garmin 18" radar for targets and weather, and Garmin sonar for clear bottom and bait detail; an Icom VHF radio keeps you in touch when it matters, a traditional compass provides a constant point of reference, and a remote spotlight extends confidence after dusk with precise, fingertip control.

Electrical equipment

Power delivery is robust and well managed, with dual new 2024 batteries providing redundancy and reserve; safety and peace of mind come from two electric bilge pumps that move water quickly and reliably, while bright spreader lights illuminate the working deck and underwater lights lend visibility and allure after dark.

Deck & console

Designed for comfort and utility, the cockpit features a protective canvas top, a freshwater shower to rinse off the salt, and a raw water washdown for keeping decks shipshape; anglers will appreciate an insulated fish box that holds the day's catch, a dedicated bait well pump feeding a live well to keep bait lively, thoughtfully placed rod holders, and a spacious deck layout that invites easy movement when the action heats up.

Trailer

A rugged aluminum bunk trailer underpins effortless mobility, with a dual axle configuration new in 2024 for stable tracking and payload confidence; also renewed in 2024 are the axles, springs, tires, and hubs, while trailer guides make centered, stress free loading and launching part of every outing.

Additional features

Completing the package, a Coast Guard safety package is aboard for readiness, with dock lines and fenders included for smooth arrivals and departures; a recently applied bottom paint adds efficiency, protection, and a clean, well kept presentation at the waterline.
