OVERVIEW

Originally built by Elsflether Werft and reborn through a celebrated, award-winning renovation in 2019, MAGNA GRECIA presents itself as a contemporary expedition-style tri-deck superyacht that marries purposeful engineering with sumptuous comfort. The refit not only lengthened her hull and enlarged deck areas but introduced state-of-the-art audiovisual systems, a full fitness center, a sundeck Jacuzzi and a helipad, transforming her into a lavish, seaworthy sanctuary.

Fresh from an exhaustive eight-month winter refurbishment, MAGNA GRECIA received a complete exterior renewal that now showcases a pristine snow-white hull, alongside comprehensive overhauls to her core systems, leaving her in immaculate technical and aesthetic condition. Measuring 63.8 m (209 ft) with a beam of 8.9 m and a gross tonnage of 850 GT, she offers voluminous, well-proportioned spaces for extended cruising.

Her accommodation is arranged to welcome up to 12 guests in 6+1 en-suite cabins, including a full-beam master suite, a VIP, two double cabins and two twin cabins, all attentively served by a professional crew of 15. Onboard amenities are extensive and refined: a panoramic gymnasium, sundeck Jacuzzi with bar and open-air lounge/disco, a beach club with a generous swimming platform, a cinema lounge, helipad and a premium Kaleidescape AV system, supported by zero-speed stabilizers, air conditioning and Wi-Fi for comfort and connectivity.

Propelled by twin Caterpillar engines of 1,550 hp each, MAGNA GRECIA cruises at 14 knots with a top speed of 15 knots and a range extending between approximately 4,300 and 6,000 nautical miles. Her timeless profile, generous volume and a comprehensive selection of water toys — WaveRunners, Jet Skis, flyboards, Seabobs, kayaks and three tenders — make her equally suited to discerning private ownership or the charter market. Originally crafted by Elsflether Werft and extensively refitted in 2019, MAGNA GRECIA has been transformed into a modern, expedition-style tri-deck superyacht, earning recognition for its award-winning rebuild. During the refit, her hull was extended and deck space enhanced, while state-of-the-art AV systems, a gym, Jacuzzi and a helipad were installed, creating a luxurious floating retreat. Most recently she completed an extensive eight-month winter refit that delivered a full exterior refresh — now presenting a striking snow-white hull — together with comprehensive updates to core systems, leaving MAGNA GRECIA in pristine condition both technically and visually. At 63.8 meters (209 feet) with a beam of 8.9 meters, she offers 850 GT of volume and welcomes up to 12 guests across six plus one en-suite cabins, comprising a full-beam master suite, a VIP, two double and two twin cabins, all supported by a professional crew of 15. Her unparalleled amenities include a full gymnasium with panoramic views, a sundeck Jacuzzi, a bar and open-air lounge/disco, a beach club with a large swimming platform and a cinema lounge, while the helipad and premium Kaleidescape AV system, together with zero-speed stabilizers, Wi-Fi and air conditioning, ensure comfort and entertainment in every sea condition. Powered by twin Caterpillar engines of 1,550 horsepower each, she cruises at 14 knots with a maximum speed of 15 knots and a range extending to 4,300–6,000 nautical miles, and her classic styling, generous volume and robust toy inventory — including WaveRunners, Jet Skis, flyboards, Seabobs, kayaks and three tenders — make MAGNA GRECIA an exceptional choice for both private ownership and charter markets.
