OVERVIEW

ISA Yachts, within the Palumbo Superyachts family, extends its next generation Granturismo line with the introduction of the 66 metre ISA GT, a contemporary reinterpretation of a celebrated run of motor yachts that advances the series' athletic elegance and cruising pedigree.

Designed by Team for Design — Enrico Gobbi, this new edition fuses sporting vigour with refined poise, its balanced proportions and inventive details expressing a modern luxury superyacht temperament. Taut, flowing exterior volumes recast the “grand ocean coupé” spirit, drawing stylistic cues from high performance automotive and aeronautical worlds to create a silhouette that is both assertive and aerodynamic.

A long, flush foredeck laid entirely in teak is conceived as a versatile lounge, appointed with minimalist furnishings, luminous inlays and dramatic fire elements that convert the fore area into a theatrical relaxation space. The distinctive ISA bow gains further presence, while expansive floor to ceiling glazing — the result of a considered stylistic approach — dissolves the boundary between luminous interiors and the open sea.

The hull is finished in a refined metallic blue grey, evoking the sheen of elite sports cars and the palette of dawn as it melts sky into water, accentuating the hull's sculpted volumes and sinuous curves. Generous, wing like side decks lead the eye aft and offer extensive outdoor living, with glass bulwarks that afford sweeping 180 degree vistas, the very hallmarks of a world class superyacht.

A defining feature is the integrated sky lounge, hugged by two lateral fins and a gentle rounded profile, a flexible domain that can serve as a dining area, fitness studio or panoramic salon and that even includes a forward Jacuzzi for elevated on deck leisure. Fore of this, the bow pulpit is rendered as a polished steel sculpture, underlining the vessel's bespoke, custom superyacht

identity.

The aft main deck is crowned by an infinity pool, framed by a broad sunning terrace fitted with sunpads and convivial seating — an arrangement ideal for bluewater voyaging and charter style relaxation. Below and throughout, interiors echo the exterior language with organic furnishings, sweeping curves and the finest materials: warm timbers, rich wenge detail, elegant marble and satin brass accents coalesce into a glamorous, contemporary atmosphere suited to a luxury motor yacht.

Accommodation begins with a full beam owner's suite located forward on the main deck, awash in natural light and offering a tranquil retreat with a generous walk in wardrobe, a double vanity bathroom and a private sitting area. Also on the main deck are two guest staterooms, each with double beds and en suite bathrooms, and below decks lie four further cabins — two doubles, one twin and one convertible — providing flexible guest arrangements for a discerning superyacht lifestyle.

The wellness area is conceived as a convivial beach club, complete with spa amenities and large fold out sea terraces that open directly to the water, reinforcing the yacht's social, user friendly layout. Throughout the design the emphasis is on sociability and intuitive use of every space while preserving the sporty, dynamic spirit that defines the Gran Turismo class.

The ISA GT 66 confirms the shipyard's command of marrying aesthetics, function and innovation, staying true to its storied tradition of excellence in crafting fully custom, high end superyachts.

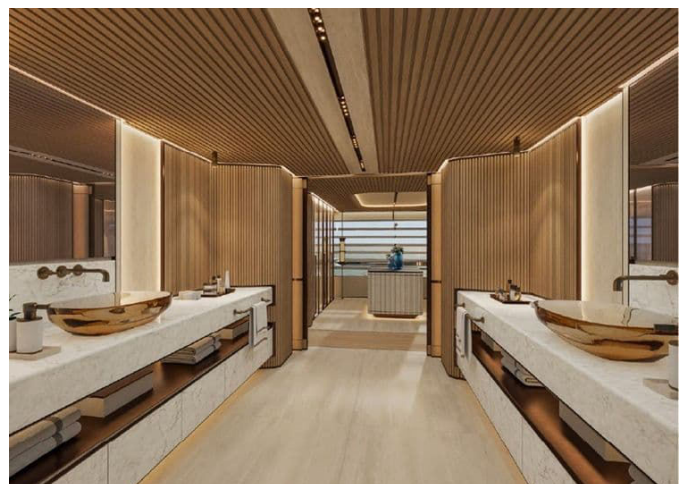
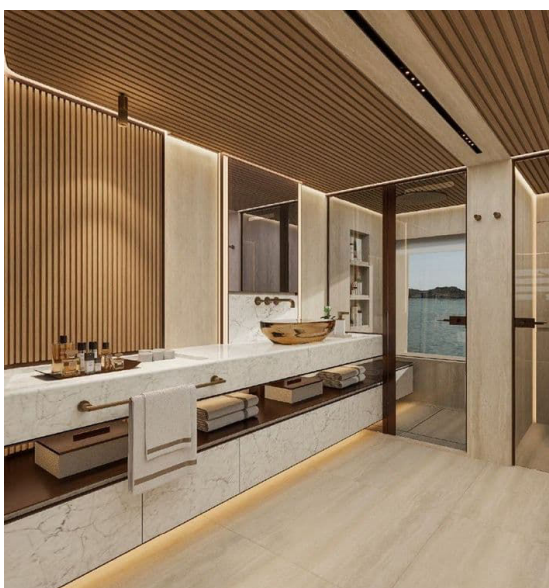

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Design & construction

The ISA Gran Turismo 66 motor yacht unites naval architecture by ISA Yachts with exterior and interior design by Enrico Gobbi – Team for Design, embodying the marque’s signature Gran Turismo poise and presence. A steel round bilge hull carries an aluminum alloy superstructure, a proven pairing that blends strength, efficiency, and low vibration, while contemporary Italian styling is matched by genuine long range cruising capability, delivering blue water comfort and composure without compromising on elegance.

Classification

Built under Lloyd’s Register of Shipping to Class 100 A1 SSC Yacht Mono G6, with notations L.M.C., UMS, and EP, the yacht meets rigorous standards for construction, machinery, and unmanned automation, underscoring reliability, safety, and enduring value.

Principal dimensions

Length overall is 66.40 m (217’8”), with a length at waterline of 65.45 m (214’7”). A broad 11.00 m (36’0”) beam and a 3.30 m (10’8”) full load draft provide impressive volume and seakindly stability. Gross tonnage is approximately 1,200 GT, with a full load displacement of 1,014 t.

Propulsion & performance

Propulsion comes from two MTU 12V4000M65L main engines, each rated at 1,771 kW at 1,800 RPM, driving through ZF gearboxes (ratio TBD). The yacht

reaches a maximum speed of 18.5 knots and settles into a refined cruising speed of 16.0 knots. Her ocean spanning range extends to 4,500 NM at 14.5 knots, or 5,500 NM at 12.0 knots, balancing pace with remarkable efficiency.

Maneuvering & stability

A fixed pitch bow thruster of approximately 150 kW enhances close quarters control, while one pair of non retractable stabilizer fins ensures steadfast tracking underway. Zero speed stabilization elevates comfort at anchor, keeping the yacht composed even in a gentle swell.

Tankage

Generous tankage underpins extended autonomy: fuel oil capacity is 130,000 L (34,342 gal); fresh water capacity is 25,000 L (6,604 gal); grey water capacity is 30,000 L (7,925 gal); and black water capacity is 30,000 L (7,925 gal).

Accommodations

Elegantly appointed accommodations welcome twelve guests in six staterooms, complemented by dedicated quarters for a professional crew of fourteen in eight cabins, ensuring discreet, attentive service around the clock.
