DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

This impeccably maintained Sea Ray 220 Sundeck, with just 387 hours on the clock, is an extraordinary vessel that seamlessly blends luxury with performance. At its core lies an enhanced 300 HP MerCruiser 350 MAG engine, paired with newly installed manifolds and risers, delivering both power and dependability. The Bravo III outdrive further boosts its capabilities, making it a delight to steer across the waves.

The yacht features protective canvas covers for both the bow and cockpit, ensuring style and safeguarding. Inside, the snap-in floor carpeting adds a layer of comfort and sophistication. Navigating is effortless with the Garmin GPSmap 547xs, complete with a transducer, while the VHF radio with a mounted antenna ensures smooth communication.

For water sports enthusiasts, the easily accessible transom with dedicated wakeboard and ski storage is a highlight. The swim platform, embellished with faux teak inserts, provides an ideal spot for unwinding or gearing up for a swim. The Sea Ray 220 Sundeck is designed for longevity, featuring a limited lifetime structural warranty on the hull and deck, along with a standard 2-year limited Mercury Installation Quality Certification.

Moreover, the yacht is equipped with SmartCraft® systems as standard, offering advanced monitoring and control for an exceptional boating experience. This vessel is more than just a boat; it is a symbol of quality and meticulous design, poised to deliver countless unforgettable moments on the water.

Propulsion

The yacht's propulsion system is driven by a powerful MerCruiser engine, specifically the 350 MAG ECT Bravo III model, crafted in 2013. This engine boasts a total output of 300 horsepower, ensuring both strength and efficiency for a seamless and thrilling journey. It incorporates an inboard/outboard engine configuration, coupled with a stern drive, enhancing both agility and performance on the water. Fueled by gas, it guarantees a dependable and steady energy source for your voyages. This propulsion arrangement is engineered to deliver both power and accuracy, making it a perfect option for those in search of a lively and responsive boating experience.

Specifications

This yacht features remarkable specifications that seamlessly blend comfort with performance. With a maximum draft of 3.33 feet and a beam spanning 8.33 feet, it provides a stable and roomy platform for all your maritime excursions. Weighing in at 4,776 pounds when dry, the vessel is built solidly to withstand a variety of water conditions.

Capable of accommodating up to 10 guests, the yacht offers generous seating, making it ideal for social events or family trips. The transom's deadrise is set at 21 degrees, ensuring a smooth and efficient voyage, even through turbulent waters.

Fuel efficiency is maintained by a single 45-gallon fuel tank, enabling longer trips without the need for frequent refueling. These specifications underscore the yacht's perfect blend of practicality and luxury, promising an enjoyable experience for everyone on board.

Other details

The Sea Ray yacht is a masterpiece of engineering and design, offering an array of features that blend functionality with luxury. The engine compartment is expertly crafted, featuring a 12V automatic bilge pump, a 12V bilge blower, and a fire extinguisher discharge port. It is gel-coated and insulated, ensuring both safety and efficiency.

The electrical systems are robust, with a battery tray complete with a mount, a fuse block, and color-coded wiring for easy maintenance. At the helm, the yacht is equipped with audible engine alarms for oil and water, a mechanical horn, and a keyless dash. The shift and throttle lever, accented with chrome, includes a trim switch and a lanyard stop switch. SmartCraft diagnostics provide comprehensive monitoring, while custom Sea Ray SmartCraft instrumentation with glass lenses and low-glare blue night lighting ensures clear visibility. The helm also features a 4-in-1 gauge, a system tachometer, a trim gauge, power-assisted steering, a tilt wheel, and a switch panel.

The hull and deck are designed with precision, featuring stainless steel bow and stern eyes, custom Sea Ray cleats, and a brass-threaded drain plug. The Arctic White gel coat and graphics package add a touch of elegance, while the high-performance vinylester resin and stainless steel hardware ensure durability. The yacht is equipped with a pop-up ski tow eye, anchor storage with a hatch and stainless-steel latch, and a tempered/tinted curved glass windshield.

The fuel system is designed for safety and efficiency, with USCG Type A-1 fuel lines and a fuel tank equipped with an anti-siphon valve and mechanical sending unit. The interior color scheme is coordinated with a quartz (grey/white) steering wheel, switch panel, and soft-touch dash instrument panel.

Propulsion is provided by a MerCruiser 350 MAG ECT Bravo III engine,

delivering 300 HP, with a non-ECT engine option available outside the US. The yacht also includes a tandem-axle painted trailer with bearing protection, dual-axle free-backing hydraulic surge brakes, submersible lights, safety chains, transom tie-down straps, a swivel tongue jack, a swing-away tongue, and an adjustable winch stand.

Seating is designed for comfort and versatility, with a bow rider featuring hinged cushions and storage below, two bucket seats with flip-up thigh-rise, slider, and swivel functions, an L-shaped lounge, and a port motorbox with dual seating and integrated transom. Propulsion accessories include a remote oil filter and a stainless steel propeller.

The cockpit is equipped with integral armrests, eight beverage holders, a snap-in carpet liner, a carry-on cooler with designated storage, a custom soft-touch dash, acrylic bow block-off and transom doors, a fiberglass stringer system, finished fiberglass flooring, stainless steel grab handles, an enclosed head compartment with a lockable fiberglass door, a portable head, LED courtesy lights, a 12V accessory outlet, and a Sony stereo system with weatherproof speakers, a subwoofer, digital cockpit remote control, and an iPod connector. Storage options include cockpit floor storage, transom-accessed ski storage, under-helm storage, and urethane storage in the bow and cockpit, all finished with marine-grade vinyl.

The yacht meets applicable USCG and ABYC standards, holds a Mercury Installation Quality Certification, and is NMMA Yacht Certified. It also features a Sunbrella canvas bimini top with a boot and stainless steel ball and socket hardware.

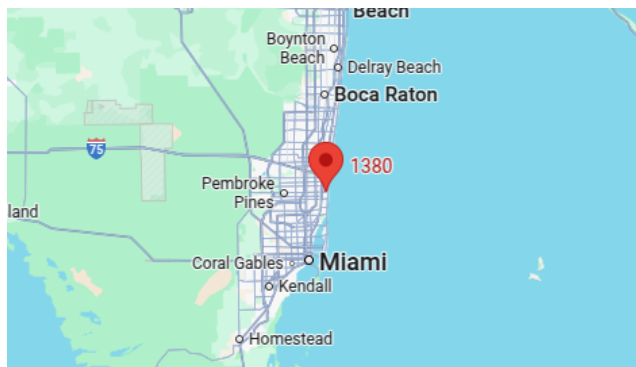
