## OVERVIEW

---

NauticStar 231 Hybrid glides between utility and refinement, a boat built to satisfy a wide spectrum of maritime pursuits. Equally at ease on offshore runs or slipping into shallow bays, this craft arrives ready for family fun with a ski/tow pylon and an extra swim platform—ideal for towing a new, never-used 3-person Super Mable tube—and it carries the Sport Package, adding a second swim platform, a bimini top and a Fusion stereo system to enhance every outing. Power comes from the upgraded, reliable Yamaha 250 SHO (listed among the options), with only 11 hours recorded on the engine, turning capability into confidence for long days on the water.

A console laid out for anglers and leisure-seekers alike houses rocket launchers, rod holders and an enclosed head with a Porti-Potti compartment, while the fishing configuration is comprehensive: two aerated live wells (noted as 17 gallons forward and 25 gallons aft), plus two insulated fish boxes and onboard 72-quart coolers. The specification sheet also lists an aft livewell rated at 27 gal and an in-console livewell/baitwell at 15 gal, with a recirculating livewell kit and a high-speed pick-up for the aerator among the available options—every detail aimed at keeping bait lively and the catch pristine. Rod storage is abundant with two stainless steel gunnel rod holders and horizontal gunnel rod holders (2 per side with SeaDek), and convenient deck arrangements include three aft jump seats with cast net/bucket storage and a livewell (27 gal) beneath the seats.

Comfort is generous aboard the 231 Hybrid, seating up to ten and offering a wrap-around deck with flip-out bolsters for languid cruising and midship bolsters for added support. The helm area is appointed with a removable rail console, a Leaning Post-DLX with flip-up bolsters in tan, an anti-fatigue helm mat, and a Fusion radio with Bluetooth and four speakers. Practical comforts continue with an insulated bow cooler, a flip-out bow backrest, a bow table

and cushion (tan), nine stainless steel drink holders and a 72 qt Igloo cooler among the options. Freshwater amenities include a fresh water kit and a low-pressure washdown, while a portable toilet and full Coast Guard safety kit (including life vest, fenders and dock lines) complete the onboard convenience. Built for durability, the hull features wood-free construction with a limited lifetime hull warranty, a vinyl ester barrier coat and a one-piece molded fiberglass stringer system; RTM fiberglass lids, an Air Assist chine and a chrome 3D NauticStar logo underscore the quality finish. Hardware appointments comprise Transshield shipping wrap, a flush mount compass, stainless steel latches, a stainless steel rub rail, stainless steel thru-hull fittings, four stainless steel cleats, engine rigging and a stainless steel propeller; an auto bilge pump rated at 750 GPH provides added security.

Electrical and electronics are thoughtfully specified with Deutsch electrical connectors, a 12V accessory plug, LED navigation lights and LED courtesy lights. Among the many added options are a 943XVS Garmin 9" display, trim tabs with LED switch, a 2-battery charger kit for crank/house batteries, spreader lights, a Standard Horizon Eclipse VHF with antenna, a fiberglass top with white powder coat to match the hull, a boat cover, anchor with 100' rode, and more—every feature selected to enhance capability and comfort.



## Electrical

---

The yacht's electrical system has been crafted for both reliability and safety, delivering a seamless onboard experience that inspires confidence on every voyage. Central to this intelligent layout is comprehensive circuit breaker protection that shields all electrical circuits from overload, while polished stainless steel toggle switches mounted on a matching acrylic panel combine durability with refined, modern styling. Robust Deutsch electrical connectors ensure secure, corrosion-resistant connections built for the marine environment, and an integrated speedometer, tachometer and fuel gauges provide the captain with immediate, easy-to-read operational data. Practical safety features include an automatic bilge pump capable of expelling up to 750 gallons per hour to keep the bilge dry, complemented by two aerator pumps, each rated at 800 gallons per hour, to support the livewell system and maintain bait and catch in prime condition. A dual battery shut-off switch simplifies power management and adds an extra layer of control, making this electrical installation both efficient and reassuringly safe for every outing.
