DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

GEORGIA ANN is a 2013 Regulator 24FS, a Lou Codega-designed center console celebrated for its truly legendary ride. Repowered in 2020 with low hour twin Yamaha 150s renowned for their near bomb proof reliability, she delivers confident performance and crisp handling that embody the Regulator pedigree. Premium stainless hardware throughout underscores the brand's top tier build quality, while a thoughtfully curated electronics suite from Garmin enhances capability at the helm. Shore side logistics are effortless thanks to a 2019 Venture dual axle trailer included with the package. From her refined fit and finish to the way she runs, this is a standout 24FS that shows exactly why Regulator is a benchmark—legendary ride, highest quality stainless hardware, a recent low hour Yamaha repower, modern Garmin electronics, and a recent dual axle trailer all come together to make GEORGIA ANN special.

Additional features

At the helm, a Garmin GPSmap 6212 chartplotter provides clear, authoritative navigation, paired with an Icom M 506 VHF radio for crisp communications. Effortless control comes from power assist steering and an Edson steering wheel, while Lenco trim tabs with position indicator let you fine tune the ride on the fly. A Bluetooth stereo brings rich sound to every passage. Offshore capability is elevated with outriggers and a proper marine head for comfort during extended days on the water. Adding to her modern equipment list, a radar dome was installed in 2024, rounding out a confident, well equipped platform.

Standard features: console

The console is engineered for command and comfort with Teleflex SeaStar hydraulic steering and a Ritchie Blue Face Supersport compass guiding every course. A fiberglass lined stand up head compartment with a proper marine toilet adds welcome privacy, supported by a breakered electrical system and a dual battery system with a dedicated battery switch for dependable power management. Visibility is superb through a frameless tempered glass windshield, while thoughtful touches include a glove box with an acrylic white lid and a recessed comfort footrest with service access. Upholstered console seating for two invites relaxed cruising, complemented by two stainless steel cup holders and two stainless steel console handrails that add both security and style.

Fishing equipment

Purpose built for anglers, the cockpit features a SuperSport leaning post with a footrest, a stainless handrail, and dedicated cooler stowage that keeps provisions and bait at the ready. Up forward, two illuminated fish boxes stand by to ice the day's catch, while a 68 qt. insulated cooler beneath the forward console seat adds chilled capacity. Tackle management is seamless with in deck locking rod storage and four stainless steel rod holders, and the transom integrates an insulated bait box. Saltwater washdown and livewell plumbing complete a smart, fish first layout that makes every strike easier to convert.

Cockpit and deck

Comfort wraps all the way around with 360 degree coaming pads, and dual fuel fills simplify refueling from either side. Night operations are supported by

dedicated cockpit lighting, while an automatic bilge pump with a float switch quietly stands guard below decks. Springline and cockpit cleats with hawse pipes provide secure, chafe free line handling. Throughout the build, stainless steel hardware is through bolted with elastic stop nuts, a hallmark of durability that speaks to the vessel's unwavering quality.
