OVERVIEW

Recently listed, the 2012 Regulator 24 FS presents itself as an upscale offshore center console that blends genuine sportfishing muscle with the polished comfort of a family dayboat. Lofted on Regulator's trademark deep V hull, she slices through blue water with a dry, confident ride while delivering ample bow seating and well-appointed creature comforts that make each outing smooth and pleasurable for everyone aboard. Power comes from twin Yamaha F150 four stroke engines, monitored by new Yamaha engine gauges and complemented by a new 24" Garmin GPS24XD at the helm; electronics include a SIONYX night vision camera and a Garmin rear camera for superior situational awareness day or night.

Thoughtfully arranged for family use, the layout features comfortable forward seating and an enclosed head, yet remains decidedly focused on fishing. Serious saltwater anglers will appreciate the 385 quart forward center fishbox with integrated rod storage, a 61 quart transom bait box, a 25 gallon recirculating livewell, and a padded leaning post fitted with four rocket launchers—an ideal configuration for an offshore sportfishing vessel that also welcomes relaxed cruising.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electronics & helm

Command with clarity from a helm outfitted for confidence, where a 24" Garmin GPS24XD anchors your navigation and a SIONYX Night Vision Camera transforms darkness into definition. The Fusion MS-RA70NSX stereo energizes four Fusion speakers for rich, underway sound, while vital performance metrics are presented cleanly on three Yamaha engine gauges so every gauge readout is immediate and intelligible. A Yamaha 704 remote control throttle and Sea Star steering deliver smooth, precise response under every maneuver, with Lenco trim tab controls refining running attitude with ease.

Communication remains uncompromised via a Standard Horizon Eclipse VHF, and a Ritchie compass stands as your unerring reference on every course, marrying modern electronics with time-tested navigation fundamentals.

Fishing equipment

Purpose-built for serious action, the cockpit is rigged with two Lee's outriggers to spread a wide, efficient trolling pattern, five hard top rocket launchers and four captain's seat rocket launchers to stage your next setups, and four gunnel rod holders to keep working rods exactly where you want them. Live bait stays lively in the 25-gallon transom livewell, while a 385-quart large bow in-deck fishbox with rod storage swallows the day's catch and safeguards spare rods. A forward anchor hatch streamlines setting the hook when it's time to stay on the bite, keeping every fishing detail arranged for instant action.

Comfort & layout

Thoughtful touches elevate every outing, with an enclosed head and storage

compartment for privacy and practicality, a forward-facing seat with an integrated storage compartment to keep essentials organized, and a folding starboard transom gate that makes boarding, swimming, and dockside transfers effortless, so every comfort is considered without sacrificing functionality or space.

Systems & additional equipment

Built for dependable days on the water, the yacht features a saltwater washdown with hose for quick cleanups, a ProSport HD12 12-amp, two-bank battery charger to keep the electrical system in peak condition, and four batteries delivering reliable starts and all-day power for electronics and accessories, ensuring systems remain ready whenever the sea calls.
