







































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features & specs

Power comes from twin 1.9L Yamaha 1898cc High Output four cylinder, four stroke EFI inboard jet drive engines showing just 37 engine hours, breathing through reliable open loop cooling for confident performance in fresh water. A thoughtfully finished head compartment with upholstered interior and lighting is designed to accommodate a Porta Potti, while Yamaha's DRiVE X dual paddle controls transform low speed handling with on axis 360° pivoting, effortless forward, reverse, or sideways movement, and precise position hold. The helm experience is delightfully modern with push button start/stop, RPM engine synchronization, single throttle lever pairing, and Quiet Cruise Technology, complemented by Cruise Assist speed control and a No Wake Mode that sharpens handling at idle speeds. Protection and style come standard thanks to a fitted mooring cover, an aluminum folding wakeboard tower with integrated lighting, and a tower mount extended Bimini top with a sunroof for airy shade across the cockpit.

Entertainment is deeply immersive: an AM/FM/Aux input/NOAA Weatherband/Bluetooth stereo system with remotes at the helm and swim platform feeds six WetSounds cockpit speakers, a WetSounds subwoofer, and an amplifier, all managed by zoned audio controls. Underfoot, MarineMat covers the integrated swim platform and continues with MarineMat teak style snap in cockpit flooring. The stern lounge invites relaxation with convertible seatbacks that conceal built in storage, a 12V outlet, a freshwater shower, a convenient stereo remote, and clever swim up seats that bring the water within easy reach.

Command and visibility are anchored by the Yamaha Connex 12.3" touchscreen multi function display with a joystick system controller and

integrated GPS/chartplotter, delivering depth, water temperature, compass heading, fuel consumption rate, fuel level, battery voltage, and more at a glance. Modern conveniences include a wireless phone charger/holder at the driver's helm, a tilt steering wheel, and a driver's flip up bolster seat with supportive armrests. Effortless control is assured with electric power steering and a dual battery setup with a selector switch, while underwater lights, docking lights, and soft courtesy lighting elevate every evening cruise.

Comfort and versatility continue with bow filler cushions, a removable lounge table with a swim platform mount, transom filler cushions, and an integrated bow windblock. Around the boat you'll find a grand total of twenty two cupholders, seven pull up cleats, a rear view mirror, a fold up cockpit table, and two dual USB 12V outlets. Boarding is easy from either end thanks to bow and stern 3 step swim boarding ladders, and stowage is abundant with an anchor locker and an in floor storage locker.

Built to impressive dimensions, this sport boat measures 24' 6" in length with an 8' 6" beam, carries a dry weight of 4,599 lbs, and is rated for 12 persons. The running surface features a 20° deadrise at the transom and a 19" draft, with 8' 1" of bridge clearance. Practicality meets capacity with 750 gallons of storage volume, a cockpit drainage system, and Yamaha's articulating keel system. It runs on regular unleaded fuel from a 75 gallon tank and features a 10 gallon fresh water tank, all wrapped in a cool touch vinyl interior that stays comfortable under the sun.

A 2024 Shoreland'r tandem axle trailer with disc brakes, a swing tongue, and a spare tire is included, rounding out a turnkey package. Proudly one owner and used exclusively in fresh water, this boat carries transferable protection: Yamaha Extended Service Warranty through 4/27/2026, Yamaha Boat Component Warranty through 4/27/2027, and a Structural Limited Warranty through 4/27/2034. For those seeking a complete waterfront solution, a front mount Premier boat lift with a transferable Norris Lake covered slip is

available for additional purchase.

Manufacturer description

The 2025 Yamaha 252SD is a premier 25 foot sport boat that embodies Yamaha's devotion to luxury, performance, and forward thinking design. Engineered for enthusiasts who demand comfort as much as capability, it unites advanced technology with premium materials to create an exceptional on water experience.

Measuring 24.5 feet in length with a beam of 8.6 feet, the 252SD delivers a spacious, stable platform for everything from leisurely cruises to spirited watersports. Its dry weight of approximately 4,612 pounds underscores a robust build that tracks confidently, while a 1.58 foot draft invites exploration of relatively shallow waterways without sacrificing poise.

Power comes from twin 1.9L High Output Yamaha marine engines. These four stroke, four cylinder, sixteen valve powerplants are celebrated for smooth acceleration, strong top end, and the kind of towing muscle watersports demand. Jet propulsion elevates maneuverability and safety by eliminating exposed propellers, making it a natural choice for families and riders alike.

A standout innovation, DRiVE X, transforms close quarters control, enabling intuitive forward, reverse, and even sideways movement that makes docking and tight space handling refreshingly simple, even for newer captains. At the helm, a 12.3 inch Connex touchscreen with maps centralizes vital data and control of boat systems, including Yamaha's E Series conveniences such as drive by wire integration and blue LED lit switch panels, while integrated wireless charging keeps devices topped up.

Passenger comfort has been elevated with a deeper cockpit and convertible stern seatbacks that slide fore and aft to tailor social zones between stern and

cockpit, whether you're lounging, chatting, or gearing up for a tow. Entertainment is equally premium, featuring a marine stereo with seven standard Hertz speakers, including stern speakers and a stern stereo remote for effortless control, while LED accent lighting and an extended Bimini top set the mood and provide generous shade.

Clever storage and convenience are everywhere: a dinette table mount, marine grade matting, stern wet storage, and a freshwater shower for rinsing off after a swim. Factory installed swim up seat brackets and included accessories make slipping into the water as inviting as returning aboard. With a 75 gallon fuel capacity, efficient twin engines, and Yamaha's hallmark Quiet Cruise Technology, longer adventures come naturally. For confident operation in regulated zones, the three position No Wake Mode and Cruise Assist provide precise speed management, while a dual battery setup safeguards reliable power.

Outside, form meets function with stainless steel bow rails, seven stainless steel pop up cleats, and a solid tow hook for watersports. The extended Bimini keeps the sun at bay, and underwater lights lend evening runs a touch of elegance. Altogether, the 2025 Yamaha 252SD stands as a compelling blend of luxury, technology, and athleticism—equally ready for avid watersports enthusiasts and those who prize relaxed cruising with family and friends.


