




# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Laurel 240'/73.15m Delta 2006/2014 Specs

---

The Laurel is an exquisite 240-foot vessel, crafted in 2006 and refined in 2014, seamlessly blending opulence with cutting-edge technology. At its core are two robust Caterpillar 3516B engines, each providing 2500 horsepower at 1650 rpm, with a comprehensive overhaul completed in November 2019 to adhere to class standards. The yacht is powered by three Caterpillar C9 generators, guaranteeing a consistent energy supply, complemented by an emergency Cummins generator for added peace of mind. Fuel efficiency is maximized with an average consumption of 20 gallons per hour, and the Magnus 1B-100-101 shore power system ensures uninterrupted connectivity while docked.

The yacht's stability and agility are enhanced by Quantum QC1800 stabilizers, a Jastram BU40F bow thruster, and a Jastram W20 Azimuth stern thruster. Water supply is managed by two HEM 4800 reverse osmosis watermakers, each producing 18,000 liters daily. Entertainment and connectivity are exceptional, featuring a Crestron AV system, dual Intellian V130NX VSATs, and a wide selection of LED HDTVs, Apple TV, and Xbox 360. The cinema room, transformed from a library, provides a Kaleidescape movie library for a captivating viewing experience.

On deck, the Laurel is equipped with sturdy facilities including Muir windlasses and capstans, a Nautical Structures MOB crane, and a passerelle. The tender garage contains a range of Nautica RIBs and Yamaha jetskis, offering numerous options for aquatic adventures. Security is a top priority, with a Frankentek system, Notifier fire detection, and Marioff Hi-Fog water mist fire protection.

The galley and laundry areas are designed for optimal efficiency and convenience, featuring premium appliances from MKN, Vulcan, Cospolich,

Hobart, and Miele. Guest accommodations are lavish, with a master stateroom on the main deck and several king and queen staterooms, each with ensuite showers and twin sinks. A distinctive feature is the massage room, which can be adapted with a queen and twin Murphy bed, providing versatility for guests. For those passionate about fitness, the yacht is outfitted with TechnoGym equipment, including a stationary bike, elliptical, treadmill, weight machine, and free weights, ensuring guests can maintain their fitness routine while indulging in the luxury of the Laurel.

## **Laurel 240'/73.15m Delta 2006/2014 Description**

The Laurel is a distinguished 240-foot yacht crafted by Delta Marine, recognized as a landmark in American yacht construction. Conceived by the renowned designer Donald Starkey, this vessel is replete with luxurious features, offering an unmatched experience for up to 12 guests. Its vibrant blue hull and timeless design make the Laurel a symbol of sophistication and a favored choice for charters, presenting an enticing opportunity for discerning owners.

The yacht's intelligent design merges cozy social areas with expansive deck spaces, ideal for hosting gatherings. The interior showcases exotic woods, glass, and expansive windows, creating an airy ambiance with a 40-foot beam. Key features include a spa pool, gym, a vast beach club, and seven staterooms. The Laurel is particularly family-friendly, with a setup that includes numerous toys to keep everyone entertained. Guests can easily access the water through the beach club and move between decks via the elevator.

The adaptable cabin layout offers various options, such as an on-deck master suite, four identical king cabins, a queen with a single and pullman, and an optional seventh cabin with Murphy beds or a massage table. The full-beam owner's suite is a sanctuary, complete with two private balconies, a service alcove, lounge, study, and his and hers ensuite bathrooms.

The yacht's social spaces are generous, featuring a library and media room for movie nights or intimate cocktail gatherings. For outdoor dining, there are two spacious areas on the aft and bridge decks, while the sun deck includes loungers and a jacuzzi. The sky lounge acts as a secondary salon, offering air-conditioned comfort with a view.

On the main deck, the salon features a classic club style with glossy burlwood and large windows, providing ever-changing vistas. The formal dining salon, situated forward of the main salon, seats up to sixteen guests at a high-gloss table. The master suite boasts a private office, perfect for conducting business while at sea, and private balconies for morning coffee or evening drinks. The ensuite is adorned with antique travertine and gold leaf, featuring his and hers sinks and a double shower room.

The bridge deck exudes a relaxed vibe with stunning views, ample seating for leisure, and a large shaded dining area. The sun deck is versatile, equipped with large sunpads, chaise lounges, a jacuzzi, and a well-appointed gym. The observation lounge can serve as a sitting room or for intimate dinners, with a wet bar shielded by removable sun sails.

On the lower deck, six guest cabins offer diverse configurations, including king suites with ensuite bathrooms and queen suites with bathtubs. The seventh stateroom can function as a massage room or staff/security room, complete with a Murphy bed and ensuite head with a Jacuzzi tub.

The engine room is engineered for safety and comfort, with robust systems ensuring reliable performance. Tenders and toys are securely housed in garages, keeping deck areas clear for guest enjoyment. The Laurel guarantees a maritime adventure with absolute assurance.
