OVERVIEW

Immaculately appointed and lovingly maintained, this World Cat 260 DC X dual console power catamaran presents as nearly new with low hours, a perfect fusion of dayboat elegance and offshore sportfishing capability. Twin white Mercury 200 hp XL four stroke engines, paired with Optimus joystick controls, give intuitive handling, effortless docking and precise station holding while you fish or wait for a strike. An aluminum trailer accompanies the boat, and factory coverage extends through 2027, offering continuity of protection for seasons ahead.

The bow is conceived for practical use and refined comfort alike, with twin anchor locker hatches and an above deck windlass complete with chute, anchor, line and chain. Low profile split bow rails enclose plentiful storage: a lockable oversized starboard compartment with rod racks, an insulated portside box, and a centerline hold—arrangements that make the boat equally at home as a family cruiser, weekender, or instant saltwater fishing platform.

The helm is crafted for both form and function, featuring a stitched dash brow and an integrated electronics suite centered on a 12" Garmin display, Garmin VHF 115, and a tidy push button switch panel. A dedicated coaming shelf keeps devices safe and charged via USB, while a battery bank comprising one Group 31 house battery and two Group 27 crank batteries supplies dependable power for long days afloat. A second Garmin GPSMAP 8612 augments the navigation package, creating a premium piloting station befitting a sport yacht or coastal cruiser.

Cockpit ergonomics prioritize fishability and flow: courtesy lighting sets an inviting tone, a port saltwater washdown streamlines cleanup, and six rod/cup stations—four gunwale rod holders plus two combo cup/rod holders—stand ready. Range is assured by 180 gallons of fuel carried in two under deck tanks with inspection access, while port and starboard mechanical hatches make

service to pumps and rigging straightforward. A 10 gallon freshwater tank supplies a pull out transom shower; a lighted 30 gallon livewell to starboard, a 120 quart insulated cooler/fishbox to port, and a versatile centerline transom walkthrough complete a cockpit equally suited to offshore trolling or sandbar leisure.

The helm deck enhances comfort and utility: the captain's chair includes an aft drink box and a Corian prep/bar center with tackle storage, and the portside companion seat cleverly converts forward or aft, offering a lounge backrest plus its own insulated fishbox. A stand up head finished with a molded fiberglass liner and synthetic sole houses a marine toilet with a 7 gallon holding tank and overboard discharge for extended runs. A black powder coated tempered glass windshield with canvas track pairs with a free standing white powder coated hardtop frame supporting a fiberglass hardtop fitted with LED spreader lights fore and aft, four recessed tri color LEDs, and provisions for outriggers—features that underscore the boat's dual nature as both a serious sportfisher and a refined family dayboat.

Upgrades elevate entertainment and night visibility: a JL Audio system driven by a 600W amplifier energizes M Series speakers—two 6.5" forward, two 7.7" at the helm deck, and two additional 6.5" in the cockpit—while a T top mounted forward LED light bar brightens passage after dusk. RGB lighting across the hardtop and courtesy areas, color matched speaker illumination, and an LED underwater light package add atmosphere and presence at anchor.

Shade and watersports options are comprehensively addressed. A deluxe stainless pipe Bimini with anchor light, boot and stand up storage provides flexible cover when the hardtop is not in use, while a hardtop rocket launcher with integrated ski tow broadens the boat's family friendly repertoire. A forward bow shade combines with a GEMLUX cockpit flyshade for all day protection, and the GEMLUX deluxe outrigger system with 18' collapsible poles

readies the boat for serious offshore runs.

Merging the smooth, stable ride characteristic of a power catamaran with the adaptability of a dual console, this 260 DC X is a rare sportfish dayboat that moves seamlessly from focused angling to elegant entertaining. With low hours, an included trailer and warranty coverage through 2027, it arrives as a turnkey coastal cruiser, weekender and saltwater fishing yacht prepared for your next adventure.
