## OVERVIEW

---

Meticulously maintained and much loved, this iconic Mackenzie Cuttyhunk Bass Boat was built in Rhode Island in 1964 and faithfully follows original production specifications. A single screw inboard skiff, she measures 28' in length with an approximate 8'10" beam and about a 3' draft, her timeless Downeast silhouette carrying the air of a Classic Motor Yacht prized by collectors. She has spent the majority of her life on Barnegat Bay, sheltering each season under a covered in water shed at Arnold's Boat Basin and Johnson Brothers Boat Yard, and her pedigree has been recognized with multiple ACBS awards.

Propulsion is provided by a fresh water cooled 318 cubic inch V8, rated at 220 HP and rebuilt in 2000; the hour meter now reads just over 80 hours, the engine solidly mounted to the stringers and running smoothly. Fuel is stored in two welded aluminum tanks located to port and starboard beneath the aft cockpit sole. A 2022 marine survey is available on request, with the full equipment list detailed therein, and she comes with a new winter cover and frame. An elegant vintage inboard dayboat with proven heritage, she is attractively priced for a timely sale.



# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

## Overall

---

Well maintained and unmistakably iconic, this Mackenzie Cutty Hunk Bass boat, built in Rhode Island in 1964, remains a beloved classic with enduring appeal. The hull is a stock design single screw inboard powered skiff that measures twenty eight feet overall with an eight foot ten inch beam and draws approximately three feet, delivering the timeless lines and handling that have made her a favorite on the water. She has been stored each season under an in water covered shed at Arnolds Boat Basin and Johnson Brothers Boat Yard and has spent the majority of her life on Barnegat Bay, accumulating many ACBS awards over the years that attest to her pedigree and presentation. Propulsion is via a single 220 HP, 318 cubic inch displacement, eight cylinder fresh water cooled engine that was rebuilt in 2000; the hour meter now reads just over eighty hours, and the powerplant is solidly secured to the stringers and runs very well. Fuel is carried in two welded aluminum tanks located to port and starboard beneath the aft cockpit sole. A 2022 marine survey is available upon request and outlines the full equipment list, and the boat also includes a new winter cover with frame. Offered at a competitive price, she is ready for a new owner who appreciates classic styling, provenance, and careful maintenance.
