

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

RASCAL exemplifies the celebrated Eldridge-McInnis lineage, crafted by Fortier Boats with exacting attention to detail, and presents a timeless profile where classic lines marry genuinely impressive seakeeping to create a vessel equally at home on a carefree afternoon picnic or a lingering weekend escape; meticulously cared for by her owners over the past four years and enjoyed only during light summer months, she presents beautifully, and recent notable upgrades — including fresh Awlgrip Flag Blue hull paint, a renewed engine and drive train, a Sidepower bow thruster, a Zipwake dynamic roll and trim system and additional improvements detailed herein — make this newly offered RASCAL an outstanding opportunity to acquire an enduring design in truly pristine condition.

Accommodations

Below, the V-berth welcomes with fitted cushions and an overhead bulkhead shelf, while an access door above grants entry to the forepeak locker; to port a Jabsco manual head, new in 2024, conceals neatly under the berth and is plumbed to a holding tank with a Y-valve for proper management, and the compact galley is intelligently arranged with an Origo two-burner alcohol stove set above a storage locker with an enclosed locker above, while a single stainless steel sink supplies pressurized hot and cold water with a shelved locker below and an enclosed locker above to ensure organized stowage.

Electronics

Command and situational awareness are assured by a Garmin 840 XS

GPS/plotter paired with HD radar, all new in 2018, complemented by a Horizon VHF and a precise Ritchie compass for dependable navigation in all conditions.

Electrical system

The yacht is wired with a 12 volt DC/110 volt AC electrical system with dedicated switch panels, supported by a 100 volt/30 amp shore inlet for convenient dockside service; engine and house battery banks, entirely renewed in 2024, provide robust reserves, while a battery charger installed in 2025 keeps the system properly maintained.

Engine/mechanical

Power is delivered by a Yanmar 250 hp four-cylinder diesel, model 4LV 250, installed new in 2025 and showing only 30 hours, with smooth control via Morse engine controls and a matching engine panel at the helm fitted in 2025; propulsion has been further refreshed with a new propeller and drive shaft installed in 2025, while filtration is handled by a Racor fuel filter, and manoeuvrability and ride comfort are elevated by a Sidepower bow thruster installed in 2023 and a Zipwake system for dynamic roll and trim control installed in 2025; fresh water is pressurized and supplemented by a 4-gal hot water heater and an aft hot/cold shower, with a saltwater washdown for quick cleanups, and a Rule automatic bilge pump stands ready for reliable dewatering.

Cockpit

The helm is appointed with Pompanette helm and passenger seats whose cushions were renewed in 2022 and under which a handy storage locker is tucked beneath the port-side seat; additional comfort is provided by fully

cushioned engine hatch seating refurbished in 2022 and a full-width transom seat with supportive backrest cushions refreshed in 2022, while boarding steps with mounting options to port and starboard make coming and going effortless.

Hull, deck and misc

Her Awlgrip Flag Blue hull, refinished in 2024 with a white cove stripe, a crisp boot stripe, and a red bottom, gleams alongside a rub rail at the shear capped with a stainless striker; varnished teak defines the windshield, handrails, cabin nosing, toe rails, and cockpit trim, all exterior brightwork having been stripped and rebuilt with eight coats of new varnish in 2023, while a custom teak helm station presents warm craftsmanship under a Stamoid bimini top with side curtains and windshield sunscreens for comfort at anchor or underway; a swim platform with a drop-down swim ladder and a stainless bow rail enhance safety and access, and on deck there is one Bomar deck hatch and four Bomar opening ports in the cabin plus a teak anchor pulpit with roller, with ground tackle that includes a Delta 15 lb anchor with rode and chain and a safety and gear inventory featuring four PFDs, flares, docklines, three covered fenders, two fire extinguishers, and a varnished ensign pole.

Owner's personal effects and folding chairs are expressly excluded from the sale.
