OVERVIEW

The 2022 Streamline 26 Center Console is a 26-foot expression of purpose and polish, built on an 8.6' beam and propelled by a Mercury 350 Verado that launches this nimble center-console to a 52 MPH top end while settling into a confident 40 MPH cruise. A seafoam hull finish is matched to a powder-coated, color-matched T-top that lends both style and shade, while thoughtful accommodations — a fold-down transom bench and a helm leaning post with a slide-out cooler tray — keep comfort and utility close at hand. Technology and entertainment are integrated with finesse: a Garmin 8612 xsv multifunction display guides navigation, a Fusion RA-770 sound system and Rockford Fosgate speakers fill the cockpit, and a windlass anchor package makes anchoring effortless. A side dive/swim door affords easy water entry, a rigid LED light bar broadens visibility, and a 150-gallon fuel capacity combined with lightweight fiberglass construction gives this versatile dayboat the range and agility for offshore and bay fishing, coastal cruising, or elevated family outings. A custom Rocket trailer is included, completing a turnkey package ready for immediate adventure.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Notable upgrades

Premium upgrades elevate both performance and aesthetics, beginning with a seafoam color that sets a fresh, distinctive tone and carries through every surface. A T-top finished with matched powder coating transitions seamlessly into a hard top paint finish for a cohesive, resilient look that stands up to salt and sun. Practical, confidence-inspiring additions include a ProMariner Pronautic 1240p marine charger to keep onboard power optimized, a custom Rocket trailer for secure and effortless transport, and a Rigid light bar that dramatically improves nighttime visibility.

Deck

Purposefully minimalistic for pure functionality and ease of use, the deck forgoes guest cabins and heads to maximize open space and freedom of movement. Generous seating is arranged throughout the cockpit, while foldable transom seating is ready to appear at a moment's notice, complemented by a 26' captain's chair and a 26' leaning post with a pull-out cooler tray that keeps refreshments close at hand. Anglers benefit from Gemlux rod holders positioned for efficient work, a dive door simplifies water access, and a windlass package with backing plate accelerates anchoring; overhead the T-top with powder-coated finish crowns the cockpit with reliable shade and long-term durability.

Electronics

The helm is comprehensively outfitted with modern navigation and entertainment systems, anchored by a Garmin 8612 xsv chartplotter and

supported by a Fusion RA-770 head unit, Rockford Fosgate subwoofers and speakers, and Fusion 8.8" 330-watt speakers for a rich, full audio experience. Communication and sensing gear include an Icom 400BB VHF hand-held radio paired with a Shakespeare four-foot antenna and a B75 Air Mar transducer to deliver accurate depth and fish-finding information directly to the helm.

Mechanical equipment & engine

Performance and reliability are delivered by a Mercury 350 Verado outboard engine with ninety hours of use, offering a maximum speed of 52 MPH and a comfortable cruise at 40 MPH that balances pace with endurance. An Airmar transducer feeds precise depth and sonar data to the helm for confident navigation and fishing, while the 26' leaning post with a pull-out cooler tray consolidates storage and keeps the cockpit organized and mission-ready.

Electrical system

Efficient and robust electrical capabilities are anchored by a ProMariner Pronautic 1240p marine charger, ensuring healthy batteries and rapid recovery during extended use, while a Rigid light bar transforms low-light conditions and extends usable hours. The integrated electronics throughout the vessel are powered by proven, reliable systems designed to support both safety and leisure operations.


