## OVERVIEW

---

The Jeanneau NC 795 Series 2 captures the spirit of open water with crisp European lines and a versatile temperament, a 26-foot cabin cruiser and weekender crafted for spirited outings or tranquil coastal retreats. Named Therapy Session, she is propelled by a Mercury 225hp FourStroke with only 112 hours, delivering hushed, confident performance and a top speed reaching 38 knots. An asymmetric walkaround grants secure, effortless movement to the foredeck while the spacious cockpit invites conviviality with adjustable seating, a removable dining table and a retractable bimini that tailors sun and shade to the moment.

Below decks, light-filled, intelligently arranged spaces provide all the comforts for short cruises: a convertible V-berth, a compact galley with refrigerator and sink, and a fully enclosed head combine to make this pocket yacht a refined family dayboat and overnight companion. The helm is equally thoughtful, where a Garmin multifunction display, Fusion Bluetooth audio and VHF sit ready beside Lenco electric trim tabs to ensure smooth handling and assured control.

Framed by panoramic side glass and a wide windshield, every passage feels immersive and connected to the sea. With contemporary design, quiet efficiency and premium fit-and-finish, the Jeanneau NC 795 Series 2 demonstrates that unforgettable cruising requires not a large motor yacht but the right express cruiser.

## Exterior design

---

Sleek, sporty, and seaworthy, the Jeanneau NC 795 wears its European pedigree with a versatile, modern profile that reads as both luxurious and purposeful; a deep blue hull and sculpted lines draw attention at every marina while the protected wheelhouse and open aft cockpit strike a confident balance between comfort and adventure, and extended swim platforms with polished stainless steel rails elevate safety and style so that family cruising or quick weekend escapes feel effortless from the dock to the open sea.

## Cockpit comfort

---

Open, social, and relaxed, the spacious cockpit transforms from lounging to dining in moments, with an aft bench that slides forward to provide extra engine clearance and a folding table that sets the scene for sunset dinners on the water; soft, marine grade cushions and a retractable bimini let you dial in shade or sunshine on demand—ideal for sandbar days or unhurried canal cruising.

## Helm & navigation

---

Command with confidence from a helm station equipped for clarity and control, featuring a Garmin multifunction display, Fusion Bluetooth stereo, VHF radio, and Lenco electric trim tabs; a large windshield and generous side windows flood the cabin with daylight and deliver excellent visibility, making navigation smooth and enjoyable whether you're exploring inland waterways or tracing the coastline.

## Cabin & interior

Comfort below deck comes naturally in a bright, cozy cabin with a convertible V berth, a practical galley, and an enclosed head compartment, where premium upholstery, warm wood accents, and thoughtful storage create an inviting retreat after a day on the water; the enclosed marine head with sink and faucet adds privacy and convenience that make overnight stays easy to embrace.

## Performance

Reliable power and efficiency define the experience, with a Mercury 225 hp FourStroke outboard delivering smooth, quiet thrust and low maintenance ownership; the hull design planes quickly and handles beautifully, inspiring confidence in both calm and choppy conditions, while trim tabs and hydraulic steering further refine ride comfort and control so every mile feels composed.

## Walkaround access

Her asymmetrical layout grants a wide starboard side walkway that makes reaching the bow safe and effortless, while stainless steel handrails and a flush deck design encourage easy movement for anchoring or sunbathing, all without sacrificing valuable interior space.

Smart, practical, ready: a shore power inlet with battery switches keeps onboard energy simple and safe, while electric and manual bilge pumps add reassuring redundancy; a freshwater system with cockpit shower refreshes after a swim, and the galley's refrigerator, stove, and sink make mealtimes

effortless, while entertainment flows through a Fusion audio system and cockpit speakers to bring your soundtrack to the open air.
