Skip the wait for new: this immaculately maintained 2024 Jeanneau 795 Sport shows exceptionally light use, with cockpit cushions stored indoors and fewer than 50 hours on the Yamaha 250 outboard. Owned by a snowbird who has recently sold their waterfront residence, this pilothouse sport cruiser presents in showroom-caliber condition and will satisfy the most exacting buyer.

Crafted for those who crave exploration, the 795 Sport marries Scandinavian-inspired lines with all-weather capability and practical utility. Expansive, secure side decks and the NC Sport walkaround configuration simplify line handling and movement aboard, while integrated rod holders and a cockpit lounge that converts instantly from alfresco dining to a casting platform provide flexible functionality for family cruising and serious fishing alike. Precise close-quarters maneuvering is delivered by a Sleipner bow thruster complemented by a Zipwake trim system, and Hullmaxx bottom coating enhances efficiency and reduces maintenance. The enclosed wheelhouse offers year-round comfort, including 12V air conditioning that makes quiet nights at anchor especially pleasant.

Underway, the Yamaha 250 outboard supplies smooth, efficient propulsion, and Garmin navigation equipment provides dependable guidance when pursuing the horizon on a weekend escape. Equally suited as a first cabin cruiser or a capable next-step adventure platform, this trailerable, outboard-powered coastal cruiser brings big-boat refinement in a conveniently managed footprint. From sunrise casts to autumn getaways, the 795 Sport's pilothouse, weekender, and sportfishing attributes combine into a polished, go-anywhere companion that performs as elegantly as it appears.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Preliminary listing; more photos coming soon. Skip buying new—this 2024 Jeanneau 795 Sport has been so gently used it still feels showroom-fresh, with cushions stored indoors and fewer than 50 hours on its Yamaha F250. Owned seasonally and just released from a waterfront home, it is presented in reassuringly clean, ready-to-enjoy condition. Built for the explorer at heart, the NC Sport styling brings massive, secure side decks, rod holders, and a rugged pilothouse that shrugs off weather while bathing the helm in light and visibility. Precision handling comes from the Sleipner bow thruster and Zipwake automatic trim system, while the Yamaha 250 outboard delivers efficient, smooth performance. An upgraded Garmin electronics pack provides confident navigation, and the versatile cockpit lounge transforms in seconds from an alfresco dining area to a casting deck. The boat benefits from Hullmaxx bottom coating, and even includes air conditioning that runs on 12V power, extending comfort far from the dock. With an enclosed wheelhouse, convertible cockpit, and adventure-ready deck layout, the 795 Sport is equally at home chasing first light or stealing away for a crisp autumn escape. Whether it's your first cruiser or your next all-weather platform, this trailer-friendly package brings big-boat comfort and capability wherever the weekend leads.

Full options list

Specified in the desirable 3-door version, this 795 Sport carries an enclosed head compartment with door and porthole and the Trim Level Premier package, powered by a Yamaha F250. The upgraded Garmin electronic pack anchors the helm, while the Fusion RA70N audio pack feeds cockpit speakers with crisp sound. Ground tackle is handled by an electric windlass with helm

control and a full anchoring kit. Comfort and space multiply in the cockpit with luxury folding side benches to starboard and port, each with cushions, plus a removable cockpit table and an aft bench cushion with backrest; forward, additional cushions complement the bow sun mattress. A sliding aft cockpit sunshade extends cover as needed. Anglers will appreciate the dedicated fishing kit, a livewell in the exterior galley, cockpit side pulpits, seven rod holders across the wheelhouse, electrical deck wash with baitwell filling, and a storage rack on the roof for a stand-up paddle. Boarding is effortless via the swimming platforms. Night operations benefit from two work lights in the aft cockpit and two front headlights on the roof. Onboard conveniences include an interior fridge, wheelhouse inside curtains, a marine toilet with holding tank, and a water system serving the enclosed compartment. Handling is superb thanks to the Sleipner bow thruster, automatic Zipwake trim tabs, and a Yamaha upgraded joystick; a horn completes the safety suite. Shore power is 110V 60Hz with a battery charger, and a folding saloon table for the one door version is included among the inventory.

Features

Electrical equipment is thoughtfully specified with a shore power inlet, an inverter complementing the 12V air-conditioning system, and a battery charger to keep onboard energy reserves topped up. The electronics suite, built around the upgraded Garmin pack, brings GPS, depthsounder, and compass together with VHF, a Fusion RA70N stereo, and cockpit speakers for clear audio; an autopilot integrates seamlessly on the same network. Inside, a Sleipner bow thruster aids close-quarters handling, an electric bilge pump keeps the bilge dry, the marine head is paired with a holding tank, and climate control is assured by air conditioning. Outside, plush cockpit cushions and a removable cockpit table turn the aft deck into a welcoming social hub between adventures.

Propulsion

A Yamaha four-stroke outboard, model year 2022, delivers a total of 250 hp, showing approximately 50 hours. This outboard configuration pairs beautifully with the Yamaha upgraded joystick for precise low-speed control, while remaining quiet, efficient, and easy to service.

Specifications

With an overall length of 27 ft, a minimum draft of 1.83 ft, and a beam of 9.17 ft, this deep vee fiberglass hull balances efficiency with a confident, seakindly ride. Seating is designed for 9 aboard. Ground tackle is managed by an electric windlass. Tankage includes approximately 26 gal of fresh water and 74 gal of fuel, complemented by a fitted holding tank. The specification aligns perfectly with the boat's NC Sport mission: robust, comfortable, and ready for year-round adventure.
