A lovingly maintained Hubert Johnson Sea Skiff, this classic wooden motor yacht has graced the waters of Barnegat Bay since her launch. Crafted of mahogany planked over oak framing and driven by a reliable single-screw drivetrain, she radiates old-world refinement and the careful handiwork of a bygone era. Formerly owned by a Toms River physician and routinely serviced at deRouilles Boat Shop, she was christened Rip Tide and carries a crisp white hull paired with softly hued light blue decks. Her signature hardtop crowned by a flybridge defines the unmistakable silhouette of a traditional flybridge cruiser. Later purchased by a one-time Seaside Heights boatyard owner, she received thoughtful restorations and has been a celebrated entrant in the Antique and Classic Boat Show, Barnegat Bay Chapter, since 2009. Now stewarded by a seasoned classic-boat aficionado, she continues to receive meticulous improvements, including a professionally rebuilt transom completed in winter 2024—a rare vintage cabin cruiser that awaits your inspection.



A lovingly maintained Hubert Johnson Sea Skiff, this Barnegat Bay native has spent her entire life on these waters, offering a rare continuity of provenance that shows in every plank and polish. Built with classic mahogany laid over oak and driven by a reliable single-screw, she embodies the best of traditional construction while remaining eminently usable; her original white hull with light blue decks, given when she was christened Rip Tide by a Toms River doctor who kept her at deRouvilles Boat Shop, remains a signature part of her charm. Her distinctive hard-top design with a flybridge gives her a commanding profile and versatility on the water, and during a long stewardship under a former boatyard owner in Seaside Heights she was sensitively refreshed and presented with pride at the local Antique and Classic Boat Show Barnegat Bay Chapter beginning in 2009. Now cared for by an experienced classic boat owner, she continues to receive thoughtful upgrades that respect her heritage, most notably a rebuilt transom completed over the winter in 2024, making her as seaworthy and elegant as she is historically authentic. Come see this gem and feel the timeless character she brings to every cruise.
