

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Standard features

Thoughtfully appointed for adventure, the forward cabin (76" length, 64" width, 44" headroom over bunk) offers twin berths with storage and cushions beneath a refined headliner, with portlights fitted with screens and an overhead ventilation hatch with screen; warm cabin lighting, an electric flushing head, a console access door, and a lockable entrance door with companionway hatch complete this private retreat. The pilothouse (59" length, 82" width, 76" headroom) is wrapped in tinted windshields and features port and starboard opening front windows, plus port and starboard opening windows with screens set in anodized aluminum frames; a headliner and overhead lighting; ladder-back chairs with cushions and port and starboard aft companion seats with interior storage; a non-skid pilothouse floor, grab rails on the aft bulkhead, and two cup holders. An aluminum lockable pilothouse door with window secures the helm, complemented by a precise compass, windshield wipers, and a commanding dual trumpet horn. On deck, a pulpit with a stainless steel anchor roller leads to an anchor locker on the foredeck, while stainless steel handrails span the cabin top, the sides of the pilothouse, and the top of the trunk cabin; a stainless steel one-piece, welded bow rail (1 1/4" diameter) pairs with stainless steel deck hardware and stainless steel rod holders. Convenience abounds with additional cup holders and hydraulic steering with a stainless steel wheel, while trim tabs with instant retract and a position indicator sharpen running attitude. At the helm, an accessory panel, LED navigation lights, and LED cockpit lighting integrate seamlessly with bilge pumps with float switches, a Fusion stereo with speakers, raw water washdown and fresh water washdown, and under gunnel rod storage with toe rails. A full transom incorporates a transom door, engine bracket, boarding

ladder, insulated fish box, and livewell, serving a self-bailing cockpit (135" l, 88" w, 25" d) finished in a contrasting non-skid surface. The hull and deck joint is thru-bolted with stainless steel fasteners and protected by a heavy-duty rub rail with a stainless steel insert, with USCG flotation foam and a 10 year limited hull warranty for long-term confidence.
