Retained in freshwater since new, this Launch 28 presents a carefully chosen Heritage specification that marries vintage Chris Craft refinement with modern convenience. The Heritage appointments include full teak side and aft rails, a teak engine hatch, a complete teak cockpit sole, and a teak steering wheel, each element contributing to a warm, timeless ambiance that recalls classic runabouts while delivering contemporary comfort.

Thoughtful upgrades enhance both form and function: a polished stainless bow anchor with electric windlass, a factory hideaway blue bimini, and a color matched cockpit cover add protection and ease of use, while the audio has been refreshed with a new Clarion head unit for clear, enjoyable sound on board. A convenient day head extends the boat's usability for family outings and long afternoons on the water.

Propulsion is provided by twin MerCruiser 350 MAG MPI engines, complemented by Hardin exhaust manifolds and K&N air filters for responsive, reliable performance. The professionally refinished hull presents flawlessly and the teak surfaces gleam, signaling meticulous care and maintenance; the boat is turnkey and ready for immediate enjoyment.

The Launch 28 balances graceful style with practical design: a generous beam and expansive forward seating create exceptional comfort for the entire crew, while the broader transom platform accepts a variety of twin engine configurations—up to 425 hp—for exhilarating bowrider performance. Increased fuel capacity adds meaningful cruising range for longer, carefree days on the water. Luxury bowrider, runabout, day boat, sport powerboat, day cruiser, twin engine cruiser.
