OVERVIEW

For mariners who value toughness as much as speed, the Vector 2900 is an offshore center console that commands notice. Built by Hydra-Sports, a name long associated with stout construction, this model continues the brand's ascent into the upper echelon of bluewater sportfishing boats. The cockpit is laid out for serious saltwater work: a transom rigging station with sink, a foldaway aft bench, three insulated fishboxes, and lockable rod storage create a practical, efficient fishing platform. Immediately aft of the helm sits a lighted 55-gallon Kodiak livewell with rounded corners to keep delicate bait lively, while the transom-spanning box can be used as a second livewell, a chilled fish hold, or dry storage. The helm affords the real estate to flush-mount two 10-inch multifunction displays, and standard equipment is decidedly high-end, including a factory hardtop with electronics box, rocket launchers, and spreader lights. Inside the roomy walk-in console, a portable head is joined by a sink and a handheld shower for comfort between runs. A wraparound windshield completely shields the helm with both style and function. With 300 gallons of fuel aboard, this tournament-ready powerboat has true offshore range, allowing the 2900 to roam well beyond the inlet and remain on the bite until the boxes are full.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

For those who prize durability as highly as performance, the Hydra-Sports Vector 2900 is a center console that commands respect; built on a famously solid fiberglass hull, it blends big-water confidence with tournament-ready functionality in a seamlessly practical package. The cockpit is arranged to keep crew and deck efficient, featuring a transom rigging station with an integrated sink, a foldaway rear seat, three insulated fish boxes, and secure, lockable rod storage that preserves working space. A lighted 55-gallon Kodiak livewell with rounded corners sits aft of the helm to keep delicate bait lively, while the full-width transom box can be plumbed as a second livewell, set up as a fishbox, or left as generous dry storage to suit the mission. The helm affords dash real estate for two flush-mounted ten-inch video displays, and the factory hardtop crowns the console with an electronics box, rocket launchers, and spreader lights as part of an impressive standard-equipment suite. Inside the roomy walk-in console a portable toilet, sink, and hand-held shower make long days offshore comfortable, and a wraparound windshield fully envelopes the helm to protect the crew while preserving clear sightlines. With three hundred gallons of fuel capacity the 2900 has the range to run far offshore and linger until the insulated boxes are brimming.

Propulsion

Twin Suzuki 300 outboards from 2010 power the Vector 2900 with proven reliability and smooth, fuel-efficient muscle; each engine produces 300 hp for a combined 600 hp, turning this center console into a fast, confident offshore platform. With approximately 1600 hours on each motor, gasoline fueling, and the inherent simplicity of outboard propulsion, the installation delivers crisp

throttle response, straightforward maintenance, and the range and pace that serious anglers demand.

Specifications

Measuring 29 ft overall with a 9.67 ft beam, the Vector 2900 delivers the broad-shouldered stance and secure ride demanded by big-water anglers; its fiberglass hull is engineered for strength and longevity, pairing solid construction with a layout optimized for both fishing and family comfort. Fuel capacity is 300 gallons for extended offshore range, while onboard freshwater and holding systems support the console's sink and hand-held shower so you can stay out longer with confidence.
