A refined center-console power cat designed for serious saltwater anglers and seekers of offshore adventure, propelled by twin Yamaha 300s that produce exhilarating speed while maintaining remarkable composure and fuel economy. Measuring 30.5' LOA with a 10' beam and carrying 275 gallons of fuel, she is configured for extended runs and a soft, assured ride through following seas. The helm is equipped with twin 16" Simrad MFDs, CHIRP sonar, radar capability, and a premium JL Audio sound system. Angling amenities include dual 40-gal livewells, a Freeman 3-port sea chest, cushioned premium helm seats, and a molded T-top. An authentic bluewater sportfishing platform and a high-performance dayboat, she marries power, polish, and contemporary technology.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Deck options & fishing features

Purpose-built for serious anglers, the deck is anchored by twin 200 qt insulated forward floor boxes that swallow gear, ice, and the day's catch with ease, while twin forty gallon livewells with pumpout to port and starboard keep bait vibrant and tournament-ready, all fed cleanly through a Freeman three-port seachest that delivers reliable flow at speed; for rapid cleanups and salt-free shine you'll find two fresh water washdowns at starboard aft and mid-ship, complemented by two raw water washdowns in the same positions so every zone of the cockpit stays spotless and mission-ready, turning every outing into an efficient, professional fishing platform.

Electronics & navigation

Your helm comes alive with one Simrad 16" MFD complemented by a CHIRP broadband sounder module, a Simrad high-speed GPS antenna, and the Simrad SiriusXM satellite weather and radio module for real-time intelligence offshore, while communication is crisp via one iCOM VHF with antenna and an MFD engine display integrates propulsion data at a glance; everyday operation is effortless thanks to an accessory switch panel, an on-board battery charger, two USB ports, and two 12V under-gunnel plugs, precision trim and ride are handled by Zipwake trim tabs and the M265 in-hull CHIRP transducer unlocks clean returns across the water column, and electronic upgrades elevate the suite with a Sionyx night vision camera, a FLIR MD-625 camera, a curved light bar, four blue LED underwater lights, and four multi-color underwater and under-gunnel lights while situational awareness expands with a 24" dome radar paired with a four-foot open array radar, an additional iCOM VHF with antennas, and an upgrade to the R599 transducer with matching sounder

module; multi-function display upgrades include two Simrad 16" MFDs, one Simrad 24" MFD, and two Garmin 16" MFDs to tailor the bridge to your preferred ecosystem and viewing real estate.

Stereo system

Turn the ocean into a private stage with the Freeman Excessive Sound System, anchored by a premium head unit that conducts every note while the deck resonates with four seven inch JL speakers and the T-top carries six seven inch JL speakers to fill the cockpit with airy detail, low-end authority comes from ten ten inch JL subwoofers embedded in the deck, all driven by a meticulously tuned JL MV amp setup for clean, thunderous dynamics at any speed, and for those who demand the pinnacle the stereo upgrade steps up to the Freeman Over The Top Sound System, delivering a truly concert-grade experience underway or at anchor.

Engines & power

Choose your thrust with Yamaha 300 or Yamaha 350 power, or opt for twin Mercury 300s with Mercury electric steering for fingertip control, performance purists can specify the Mercury 300R, and precision docking is elevated with the Mercury joystick with SkyHook or the Yamaha HelmMaster EX joystick, each bringing effortless maneuverability and station-holding confidence to every approach.

Lighting

Light your pursuits with six spreader lights that blanket the cockpit, complemented by six blue/red/white dome lights to set the perfect mood after dark; blue/white under-gunnel lighting outlines the deck with a refined glow,

while LED box lights and navigation lights deliver crisp visibility and unmistakable presence wherever you run.

Leaning post & upholstery

Settle into helm seating with supportive armrests, then command the day from a deluxe leaning post that brings one drink storage cooler, two tackle centers, and a thirteen gallon freshwater tank together in a single, beautifully integrated module; forward, a cushioned coffin box with backrest and armrests invites guests to lounge in comfort, while full wrap-around coaming bolsters protect and cradle the crew during the run, and upholstery upgrades let you refine the aesthetic with a color upgrade and teak accent upgrade for the helm and coffin box seating, layering warmth and craftsmanship into every surface.

T-top & tower

A deluxe molded T-top with a powdercoated frame crowns the helm, paired with a glass windshield and wiper to cut through spray, eight powdercoated rod holders keep your spread organized overhead, and Gemlux outrigger bases stand ready for bluewater duty; the T-top upgrade expands capability with Kingfish rod holders and a stand-through tower with controls for engine and steering, an MFD display, cushion seating, and a no-slip Dekit footpad, plus carbon fiber outriggers that deploy with featherweight precision.

Hardware & rod holders

Fish with confidence using twelve Gemlux Blue Water rod holders set into the gunnel and six integrated transom rod holders, all positioned for swift, tangle-free deployment, creature comforts include twelve cup holders within

easy reach, while ten stainless steel cleats deliver secure, polished tie-ups at every dock.

Hull & color options

Make a statement from the waterline up with a palette that includes Matterhorn White, Whisper Gray, Ethereal Blue, Stars & Stripes, and Aqua Mist, each finish meticulously applied to showcase the hull's lines and your personal style.

Additional features

Thoughtful touches amplify versatility, from two additional 12V under-gunnel plugs to power accessories, to a plumbed electric marine head that elevates comfort on long runs; see-through livewell lids keep bait visible at a glance, while anglers can choose between a Rhodan trolling motor system or the Garmin Kraken trolling motor system with Livescope for precision positioning on structure, and a Reverso engine flush system simplifies maintenance, making post-trip care fast, thorough, and clean.

Trailer options

A custom 29' bumper pull trailer is available to match the boat's stature, balancing strength, tracking, and protection for confident travels to every launch.
