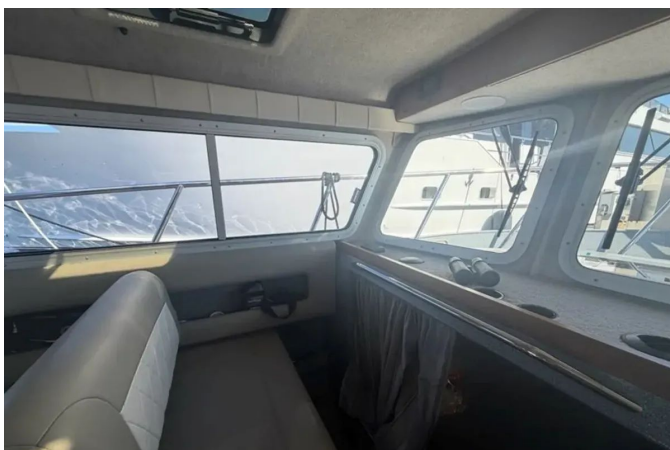

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

The 2023 KingFisher 30' is a purpose-built aluminum tender that blends rugged construction with refined capability to deliver outstanding performance, stability, and versatility on the water. Engineered for the rigors of coastal cruising, it rides on a welded aluminum hull that provides enduring strength while supporting a generous, thoughtfully arranged deck and a well-appointed pilothouse. Equally at home as a fishing platform, a comfortable cruiser, or a reliable tender, this model offers plentiful deck room, a competent pilothouse layout, and the structural robustness to confidently tackle a wide variety of conditions. The result is a practical, dependable vessel crafted for exploring the Northwest and beyond.

Pilothouse / galley

The enclosed cabin and pilothouse provide sheltered, climate-protected spaces that make for a tranquil and comfortable interior, perfectly suited to longer passages. To port, a dedicated dining and seating area creates an inviting setting for relaxed meals and conversation, while the carefully planned galley is appointed with a two-burner cooktop and a practical storage and closet area to keep provisions and personal items orderly and within easy reach.

Helm and deck layout

Positioned to starboard, the helm offers superb sightlines that inspire confident control and make navigation straightforward. A carefully conceived open deck plan encourages effortless movement throughout the vessel,

creating a graceful continuum from bow to stern. Generous seating allows guests to unwind in refined comfort, while the practical, well-considered layout is equally suited to tender-handling duties and elegant, carefree recreation.

Forward cabin

Tucked forward below deck, the cabin affords a private sanctuary with generously proportioned berths crafted for relaxed overnight comfort, an onboard head whose exact specifications remain to be confirmed, and intelligently appointed additional interior storage that subtly expands and enhances the living areas.

Propulsion & performance

Propelled by a pair of 200 HP Mercury outboard engines, this craft pairs formidable thrust with finely tuned handling to yield effortless control during tender duties and serene coastal cruising. The flexible propulsion arrangement also lends itself to longer passages, dependable yacht support, efficient sportfishing and spirited exploration, ensuring capability across a wide range of missions.

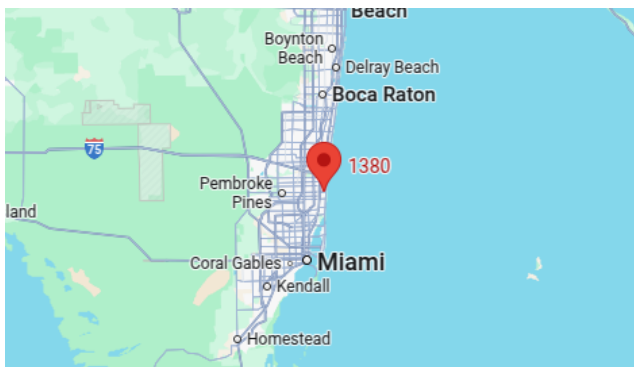
