OVERVIEW

This exceptional tender is conceived for the most demanding operations and the deepest of explorations, built to MOD standards so it satisfies the rigorous requirements of varied missions. Purpose-designed to thrive in the harsh conditions encountered in yacht tender work, this distinctive Iguana RIB is a singular offering on the market.

Its deck is supremely adaptable, fitted with multiple lifting points and aviation-grade rails that allow for flexible seating arrangements and rapid reconfiguration. Six Ulman shock mitigating seats are installed to protect occupants from impacts up to 20g, including lateral forces, a system that not only prioritizes guest safety but also reduces crew fatigue and lowers accident risk. An integrated landing gear system permits smooth touchdowns across a range of terrains, while the hull's thermal insulation allows reliable operation in extreme temperature conditions.

The U-shaped superstructure is engineered to absorb shocks and damp vibrations, delivering an unusually calm ride for a boat of this size. A self-bailing layout with oversized scuppers enables safe towing in any weather. True amphibious capability and proven all terrain performance permit secure landings even in 1.5 m seas, and the centre tracks outperform Sealegs or AMP models, giving confident handling ashore. The tender's 360° rotational ability ensures it can stay over the water during beach operations, allowing drop-offs and pick-ups without the need to drive onto the shore.

A direct-injection engine provides the torque and efficiency required for powerful, controlled beach landings, while a heavy duty ladder offers robust, easy access. Military-grade decking resists boots and sand, and the tubes are constructed from Orca 866 with double ply reinforcement and anti slip surfaces for enhanced durability and safety.

An extensive electronics suite, including a stabilized FLIR camera and radar,

rounds out the package, making this tender a formidable—and highly practical—addition to any yacht offer. For charter yachts the value is clear: heightened appeal to guests and a tangible reduction in crew fatigue, making this an outstanding option for those looking to buy a yacht in the current boat location. 
