OVERVIEW

Bold and unmistakably Whaler, this 2009 Boston Whaler 320 Outrage Cuddy Cabin marries offshore capability with refined comfort, making it exceptionally well suited to life in Puerto Vallarta. At 32 feet overall and a broad 10-foot beam, the hull's stout fiberglass construction and purposeful lines deliver the dry, composed ride the marque is famed for, inspiring confidence for adventures across Banderas Bay and farther into the Pacific.

Propulsion comes from twin Mercury outboards, giving crisp throttle response and nimble handling so that long runs feel effortless; a generous 300-gallon fuel capacity opens genuine bluewater range for extended passages. The helm is laid out with intuitive ergonomics and unobstructed sightlines that keep the skipper fully in command, with room allotted for the electronics suite of your choice to outfit the boat for navigation, fishing, or coastal cruising.

Deck arrangements reflect the Outrage's dual nature as a serious offshore platform and an inviting dayboat. The walk-around configuration, confident freeboard, wide side decks and well-placed handholds make movement safe and natural underway, while abundant lockers and storage spaces stow gear neatly and accessibly whether you're chasing pelagics or entertaining guests. Forward, the cuddy cabin introduces practical versatility — a sheltered, climate-friendly retreat for a quiet nap at anchor or a spontaneous overnight — complemented by an enclosed marine head and a 40-gallon freshwater system for added convenience.

This Boston Whaler synthesizes the spirit of an offshore fishing machine with the grace of an express-style dayboat and the utility of a compact cuddy, equally adept at trolling the open water, slipping away on a sunset cruise, or island-hopping along Mexico's Riviera. From Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, this gas/petrol-powered, outboard-driven center console with a cuddy cabin stands out as an exceptional fiberglass powerboat choice for offshore fishing,

saltwater sportfishing, and family cruising — the Boston Whaler 320 Outrage.

Take all of the fish-fighting capabilities, reliable ruggedness and performance of the 320 Outrage, combine it with the comfort of a luxurious cuddy cabin, and you've got an all-around fishing yacht/cruiser that's unparalleled in its class. In the 320 Outrage Cuddy Cabin, you'll find the space and amenities you need to enjoy overnighting, take a break from the sun and simply make more of your weekend.

Features

Thoughtful equipment elevates every outing: Mercury SmartCraft VesselView keeps critical data at a glance, while a rugged bow tow eye stands ready for tendering. Anchoring is effortless with the Quick electric windlass feeding an anchor with 35 feet of stainless-steel chain plus 100 feet of anchor line, complemented by freshwater at the anchor washdown and a transom shower. The cuddy benefits from an air-conditioning package for added comfort, and the premium entertainment suite pairs a Clarion stereo package with six JL Audio speakers and a JL amplifier. Anglers will appreciate the full fishing package and a 45-gallon livewell, while extended days are made easy by a Vacu-Flush toilet with holding tank and vacuum pump, a cockpit under counter refrigerator/freezer, and a removable fiberglass bow table. Shade and power are equally well handled thanks to a retractable SureShade sun shade over the cockpit with manual lever, multiple 12V DC input ports at the cuddy, cockpit and bow, a battery package for dual engines, and a Xantrex power inverter/charger 12V/120 volts. Protection comes from dark blue cockpit cushion covers, a dedicated cockpit rain kit, a full blue boat cover and individual black engine covers, and logistics are simplified with an aluminum

trailer with 3 axles.

Electronics recently installed (2022)

Cutting-edge navigation and awareness arrived in 2022 with a helm suite centered on Garmin multifunctional displays GPSMAP 8616xsv and GPSMAP 8610xsv, paired with Garmin UUS021R G3 Vision California–Mexico cartography. Precision steering is delivered by a Garmin Reactor 40 autopilot with SmartPump and its dedicated remote, while a Garmin Panoptix PS51 transducer, Garmin GMR 24xHD radar, Garmin VHF 115 radio and a Garmin GC-14 camera expand safety and situational awareness. Performance and control are further refined by a Lenco dual actuator automatic trim tab system, with underwater LED lighting and an ACR remote search spotlight enhancing visibility after dark and at anchor.

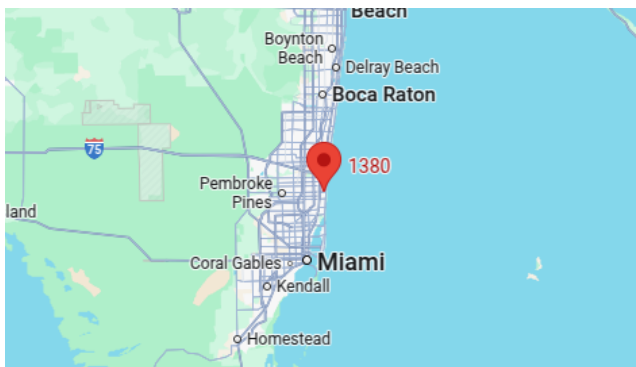
