OVERVIEW

The 2015 Yellowfin 32 exemplifies a cultivated center-console design, marrying arresting aesthetics with true offshore prowess. Created for those who insist on a swift, responsive ride, it couples clean, athletic lines with potent thrust to inspire confidence in open water. Easy at the helm and exceptionally steady in a head sea, it pampers guests with abundant seating, a wide, uncluttered deck, and the immaculate fit and finish that mark both a luxury sportfishing dayboat and a custom yacht tender.

A finely tuned hull with a knife-like bow entry and a 22-degree deadrise at the stepped transom yields brisk acceleration, unwavering stability, and an admirably dry ride. The low-profile bow rail, flush-mounted hardware, and grippy, infused nonskid facilitate genuine 360-degree fishability and effortless transit from stem to stern. Clever storage is everywhere: a large centerline dry box forward is joined by two additional forward dry lockers, while recessed shelves beneath the bow covering boards discreetly stow life jackets and essential equipment. Anglers will value twin livewells—an integrated 100-gallon pressurized tank in the leaning post and a 50-gallon tank in the transom—alongside twin saddle fish boxes in the cockpit, each offering a 600-quart capacity.

Set up as a bespoke yacht tender, this 32-foot Yellowfin features forward seating, a sturdy hardtop, and a tow eye, and it has only 575 hours on twin Yamaha 300s. The electronics package is robust, with dual Garmin GPS/radar/depth-sounder displays and a Garmin autopilot added in 2022. That same year saw fresh diamond-stitched upholstery, a carbon-fiber pole sunshade, and Gemlux outrigger bars fitted with telescoping carbon riggers, upgrades that blend form with function.

Meticulously maintained, the boat received new batteries, new bilge pumps, fresh paint on the engine covers, and a just-completed 300-hour engine service

in 2025—evidence of careful, current care. Poised as well as purposeful, this 32-foot Yellowfin stands out on the brokerage market as a polished, high-performance platform for serious sportfishing and refined day cruising alike: an offshore center console, luxury fishing boat, and tournament-ready yacht tender that elevates every outing.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

Driving the 32 is like slipping behind the wheel of a Corvette convertible: throttle response is instantaneous, the bow settles quickly to keep sightlines clear, and the hull answers the slightest course correction with poise. Oversize K-Plane trim tabs make rapid work of tuning attitude for changing loads and sea states, so she punches through waves and sheds water like a seal, inviting you to unleash your inner speed demon. Starting with a sharp bow entry, the hull flows aft to dual notched steps that ventilate the running surface and cut drag, while the stepped transom carries an assertive 22 degrees of deadrise for a soft, fast ride. Measuring a confident 9'9" overall at the beam, the stern is nearly 5 inches wider than the previous model, neatly offsetting the extra mass of four-stroke power; even with two adults leaning over the rail, the waterline scarcely moves. Aft freeboard remains low enough for clean wiring of a fish, and the bow cap is slightly lowered to better suit height-challenged anglers. The 32's layout is all clean, purposeful efficiency: a low-profile bow rail, flush-mount hardware, and infused nonskid work together to deliver true 360-degree maneuverability. The centerline bow dry box can be divided into two sections and is generous enough for beanbags; two additional dry boxes are set in the forward deck. Under the bow covering boards, a recessed shelf discreetly cloaked by a mesh panel stows life jackets and gear. For serious live baiting, twin livewells come standard: a 100-gallon pressurized tank integrated into the leaning post and a second 50-gallon well in the transom. In the cockpit deck, twin saddle fish boxes each offer 600-quarts-plus of macerated capacity to ice, sort, and store your catch.

Standard equipment

Everyday fishability and comfort come fully appointed. Forward seating features a filler cushion and a convertible table, while a forward console entry opens to a compartment pre-plumbed for a toilet. Organization is effortless with a six-drawer tackle center to starboard of the helm seat and three-drawer storage to port, complemented by two cup holders. Boarding is easy via a pull-out stern boarding/swim ladder, and shore power needs are met by an onboard battery charger. Hardware is premium throughout, with Gemlux flush-mount cleats, a stainless-steel pop-up bow light, and under-gunwale courtesy lights. Hydraulic steering keeps control light and predictable, and the white console and coaming cushions are finished with Moon Dust trim. Reliable Rule pumps serve an 1100 GPH livewell and a 1200 GPH bilge. Utility details include stainless-steel D-rings, 2-inch Gemlux fuel fills, four gunwale rod holders, and high-performance trim tabs. The helm's lighted switch panel fronts tinned copper wiring with Deutsch connectors, while an O-ring gutter system manages deck drainage. Below the waterline, Gemlux stainless-steel thru-hull fitting and Gemlux ball valves speak to long-term durability. Overhead, a T-Top with four rod holders stands ready for the run offshore. Deck duty is simplified with a saltwater washdown, an aft 55-gallon livewell, and a 530-quart macerated fishbox. In 2022, notable upgrades were added: a new Garmin autopilot, new diamond-stitched upholstery, a new bow sunshade with carbon fiber poles, and new Gemlux outrigger bars with telescoping carbon fiber riggers.

Optional equipment

Optional and notable equipment comprises twin Yamaha 300 hp outboards, a Moon Dust hull color with a white-painted bottom, and a custom powder-coated hardtop with a Moon Dust underside. Utility and angling

upgrades include a tow eye, two additional swivel rod holders, and a bow sunshade with carbon fiber poles. Electronics are anchored by an integrated Garmin suite combining GPS, radar, depth sounder, and autopilot. After dark, two underwater lights set the mood, while full covers protect the boat at rest. A fresh-water washdown adds convenience at the dock or on the drift, and Gemlux outrigger bars with carbon fiber poles expand the spread when you're hunting pelagics.
