The 2019 overhaul refreshed both cosmetics and mechanical systems, delivering a crisp, near-new appearance with a glossy gelcoat, new upholstery, and meticulously serviced hardware. At the helm, upgraded electronics, reworked wiring, and a thoughtfully organized systems layout reflect meticulous maintenance. Thanks to Intrepid's acclaimed deep-V hull, the 32 provides a soft, dry ride, an efficient cockpit workflow, and inviting bow seating. Offered turnkey, this premium center console represents exceptional value for buyers seeking a high-end offshore platform with meaningful recent upgrades.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electronics

A sophisticated electronics suite is built around two Garmin 8612 XSV units, whose crisp multifunction displays form the operational core and integrate seamlessly with a Garmin GHC 20 autopilot, an Icom IC-M330 VHF, a Garmin AIS 800 and a Garmin GT-20 transducer to provide precise navigation, dependable communication and heightened situational awareness. Equally refined, the onboard entertainment is driven by a Fusion Apollo stereo that powers four JL Audio speakers and a dedicated subwoofer, delivering rich, immersive sound throughout the yacht.

Engines

Powered by twin Mercury 275 hp engines displaying 565 hours as of April 2026, the propulsion system is overseen by an upgraded SmartCraft display that delivers precise, real time performance data. The engines were refinished with fresh paint in 2025, the scheduled 300 hour service was completed in February 2026, and a new steering pump installed that same month further enhances reliability, reflecting meticulous maintenance and attention to mechanical detail.

Deck and other equipment

Refreshed in 2019 with Plasteak decking and finished with a painted hull, the deck offers a pristine, contemporary expanse accented by LED navigation lights, red and white hard-top illumination and four Seavision underwater lights available in blue and white. Maneuvering is effortless thanks to a Vetus 12V bow thruster, Bennet trim tabs and a Lofrans windlass, while the boat's

tournament pedigree is supported by outriggers, a livewell, fresh- and saltwater washdown systems and a macerator pump, placing serious fishing capability at your fingertips. Safety and dependability are reinforced by two Rule bilge pumps equipped with USS Floats, backed by a Tournament pro elite battery charger and four Odyssey AGM batteries (Oct 2025). Comfort has not been overlooked, with an enclosed head featuring an electric toilet and sink accessed by an electric door, electric headrests on the forward seating and an aft sunshade mounted on stainless steel poles.

This 2007 Intrepid 32 exemplifies the marque's renowned offshore pedigree, marrying robust construction with a refined aesthetic and presenting in very nice condition after a comprehensive 2019 refit. The result is a center-console that deftly balances spirited performance, fishability, and family-friendly comfort, with a presence and finish that belie her model year. Her wide beam and superb fit and finish speak to Intrepid's attention to detail, while the hull's celebrated deep V profile delivers the soft, dry ride expected of an elite offshore boat.

The 2019 overhaul addressed both form and function, leaving the hull and deck with clean, glossy surfaces and meticulously maintained hardware. Seating, upholstery, and soft goods were renewed to create a cockpit that is as comfortable for long days chasing fish as it is for leisurely cruising or entertaining guests. At the helm, modern electronics, refreshed wiring, and upgraded components provide dependable, intuitive operation that reflects thoughtful ongoing care.

Storage is abundant and cleverly arranged throughout the platform, reinforcing the boat's versatility whether set up for serious offshore fishing, relaxed coastal cruising, or island-hopping excursions. The intelligent layout affords effortless movement around the cockpit while preserving spacious

forward seating, ensuring passengers travel in comfort. Turn-key and ready to enjoy, this Intrepid 32 presents an exceptional opportunity to own a premium center-console that has benefited from significant updates—delivering contemporary capability and confidence without the new-boat premium.
