Raw acceleration and agile handling are married to flawless workmanship, premium fit-and-finish, and industry-leading construction. Designed to outrun and outmaneuver its peers, this 32-foot center console cleaves through chop like much larger offshore machines while preserving the crisp, skiff-like response of a performance hull. The refined marriage of aesthetic and utility produces a bluewater sportfishing platform that is as elegant as it is capable—equally at ease stalking stripers and tarpon along the coast or punching the rips for blue marlin offshore. Perfect as a Center Console Sportfish, Offshore Dayboat, Yacht Tender, Superyacht Tender, and Chase Boat, it arrives tournament-ready, built for adventure, and approved by owners who demand both speed and sophistication.

## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### Cushion, bolsters, accessories

---

A light grey deluxe interior sets a refined tone, complemented by Yellowfin helm seating finished with Techno Grey boxing and a double-stitch diamond pattern sewn in regular clear thread, while two embroidered Yellowfin logos add a bespoke touch. Forward, front seating with flip-up backrests welcomes relaxed cruising, and a removable rear bench seat maximizes versatility at the transom. Practicality meets polish with an interior telephone booth cover and front shelf covers, and visibility is assured by a three-sided polycarbonate enclosure with wings that tames the wind without sacrificing style.

### Common options

---

Outfitted for serious adventure, the boat features 14 titanium rod holders and a freshwater washdown, plus a sturdy Garelick boarding ladder for confident reboarding. Power and convenience come together with four X electric plugs and a battery charger, while two X ShadowCaster multi color lights create an arresting glow at dusk. Ground tackle and hardware are equally robust, with a windlass flush under the bow mount, 300 mega Ply rope, 15 chain and an SS plow anchor, and organized storage courtesy of Rowan Boxes. Purpose-built fishing enhancements include a baitwell window, a tow plate, an H/D swivel, and plumbed aft fish boxes for efficient handling of every catch.

### Color

---

An effortlessly crisp palette underscores the yacht's lines: hull sides in Whisper Grey, a hull bottom in Matterhorn White, a white/grey rub rail, and a canvas finished in pure white for a timeless, nautical aesthetic.

## Leaning posts

---

At the heart of the cockpit, a medium leaning post serves as a command center, paired with a 3 open drawer tackle station and an aft tackle station to keep every lure and leader at hand. Thoughtful touches include a foldout trash can for seamless tidiness, six cup holders for crew comfort, and an extra house battery to power long days offshore without compromise.

## Electronics

---

Precision electronics elevate every passage: a B265LH 1KW BB flush mount transducer teams with dual G8617 Garmin GPS units and a GSD26 2K Chirp sounder module for crisp, penetrating imagery. A Garmin 4k Open Array 120W radar extends awareness far beyond the horizon, while a G315 VHF RAM mic and the GHP Reactor 40 with GHC 20 autopilot streamline communication and course-keeping. Seamless connectivity arrives via a card reader and GOST 1.0 GPS tracking, and entertainment comes alive with a Fusion WB670 built-in Bluetooth w/Sirius, two JL MV 1000/5 amplifiers, 4 JL subs and 8 JL speakers to flood the deck with rich, dynamic sound.

## T-tops and towers

---

The protection and presence of a hardtop with rear support legs set the stage for confident runs, complemented by hardtop running lights and 2 x LED multi color hardtop lights that tailor the ambiance from cockpit to helm. Finished in a white powdercoated T-top, the profile is as durable as it is striking.
