A refined example of purposeful design, this 2010 Intrepid 323 Open marries graceful lines with uncompromising equipment: a pair of new Garmin 8612 multifunction displays provide chartplotter and depth-sounder capability while a Garmin xHD2 open-array radar keeps you confidently aware of the surroundings. Maneuvering is effortless with a bow thruster and Bennett trim tabs, and anchoring is simplified by an electric windlass. Power is supplied by twin 2016 Mercury 400R outboards, each with current, documented service, and an onboard battery charger keeps systems ready between outings.

The deck arrangement is equally thoughtful: a fiberglass hardtop with integrated lighting and rod holders shelters the helm, which is protected by fitted covers, and all electronics are kept safe under their own protective coverings. Comfort and convenience include a Clarion stereo with Bluetooth connectivity, an electric day head, expansive forward seating with abundant storage lockers, a molded transom livewell, and a side dive door leading to an integrated swim platform with ladder. Practical extras such as a towing package for use as a yacht tender, an ACR searchlight, and an aft sunshade/awning for superior sun protection enhance versatility, while paint and cushions remain in excellent condition and the boat has been dry-stored when not in use.

For those who prize a high-speed, offshore-ready center console built to Intrepid's exacting standards, this 323 Open offers a smooth ride and immaculate presentation. A premium, multi-role platform, it slips easily from sportfishing missions to family day-cruises, serving equally well as an offshore dayboat, coastal cruiser, or luxury yacht tender — a true performance Center Console exemplifying Sportfishing excellence.
