OVERVIEW

The 32's commanding center-console helm is appointed with a rigid T-top and an overhead electronics locker, complemented by dual livewells—a 100-gallon pressurized reservoir integrated into the leaning post and a 50-gallon tank in the transom—while twin saddle fish boxes, each with 600+ quarts of capacity, are set into the cockpit sole, embodying offshore sportfishing, bluewater-ready saltwater powerboat elegance.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Design and construction

Most of the hardware outfitting the Yellowfin comes from Gemlux, a high quality metals specialist, including a stainless steel pop up bow light, two inch stainless gas fills, and stainless thru hulls paired with precise ball valves, all chosen to deliver lasting corrosion resistance and flawless function. Yellowfin laminates each boat with Core Cell composite to achieve superb structural strength without unnecessary weight, and every hatch is finished in a glossy gelcoat inside and out and sealed with a gasket to ensure uncompromising watertight integrity. Electrical connections are executed to the same exacting standard, with tinned copper wiring and waterproof Deutsch connectors engineered to provide long term reliability even in the harshest marine environments, resulting in a build that feels as refined and trustworthy as it is purposefully rugged.

Standard equipment

Thoughtful standard fitout begins with a side console entry door and a helm seat that integrates a six drawer tackle center to starboard and a foldout trash can to port, complemented by two cup holders to keep essentials organized and accessible. Safe, easy access to the water is provided by a pull out boarding and swim ladder at the stern, while an onboard battery charger ensures systems are always ready. Hardware is Gemlux throughout, from flush mount cleats and two inch gas fills to stainless steel thru hull fittings and ball valves, joined by a stainless steel pop up bow light and stainless steel D rings that add both function and finishing detail. Night moves are made effortless with under gunwale courtesy lights and a lighted switch panel, and precise handling is delivered by hydraulic steering and

high performance trim tabs. Comfort is elevated by a white console and coaming cushions trimmed in Moon Dust, and the rigging is executed to a yacht grade standard with tinned copper wiring, sealed Deutsch connectors, and an O ring gutter system for superior protection. Anglers will appreciate four gunwale rod holders plus a T Top outfitted with seven rod holders and two additional swivel rod holders, an outrigger, and a fifty five gallon livewell aft supplied by Rule pumps with an 1100 GPH baitwell pump and a 1200 GPH bilge pump, complemented by a 530QT macerated fishbox; washdowns are handled by a dedicated saltwater system. Navigation and entertainment are equally well covered with a Garmin GPS/Radar/Depth Sounder, an upgraded C Zone system, a JL Audio sound system, and a Fusion radio, while the hull bottom is finished in Matterhorn white and the rub rail is matched in white for a clean, cohesive appearance.
