OVERVIEW

Sweet, swift, and endlessly capable, this luxury tender and chase boat leaps to 60 mph on twin 350s that have been fully serviced, the powerplants upgraded to 2017 350 Verados showing ideal compression and paired with both lower units at zero hours following fresh rebuilds. A \$5,000 tow eye is included with a premium tow bridle and 150' line, while outriggers and a rugged hardtop transform her into a serious sportfishing center-console when the mood and the sea demand it. Beneath the helm a proper standing head with shower complements a surprisingly spacious cabin, and new helm and aft cushions heighten onboard comfort as Lenco racing trim tabs sharpen handling. The cockpit enclosure and spare parts come aboard, storage is abundant throughout, and she performs superbly as an exceptional superyacht tender, dayboat, and offshore fishing machine.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Purpose-built as both a sweet, serious tender and an all-out fishing machine, this thirty-three footer delivers about sixty mph on twin 2017 Verado 350s and settles into an easy 34.76 kn cruise. The engines show perfect compression, and both lower units have zero hours since fresh rebuilds, inspiring immediate confidence. Rigged to tow with a \$5,000 tow eye, it comes complete with a tow bridle and a 150' tow line. Offshore ready details abound, from outriggers to a robust hardtop that shelters a well organized helm with new cushions, mirrored aft by fresh upholstery in the cockpit. Beneath the helm, a surprisingly spacious cabin offers a full stand up head with shower and a comfortable, airy interior, turning quick runs into unrushed getaways. Lenco racing trim tabs dial in the ride, while a wealth of storage, a full enclosure, and a cache of spare parts make life on board practical and effortless.

Features

Everyday utility meets offshore capability with a thoughtful specification that reads like a wish list. The electronics suite covers the essentials with a depthsounder, radio, compass, GPS, cockpit speakers, and VHF, ensuring you navigate with clarity and arrive with music. Inside, the boat is equipped with an electric bilge pump for dry confidence, a marine head complemented by an electric head for effortless operation, and a battery charger to keep power reserves topped up. On deck, comforts and practicality continue with a cockpit shower, outboard engine brackets, plush cockpit cushions, a convenient swimming ladder, and outriggers ready for the spread. Add the Lenco racing trim tabs, the tow eye with tow bridle and 150' tow line, a full set of enclosure panels, abundant storage everywhere you look, and even spare parts on hand,

and you have a platform that's turnkey for fun, fishing, and fast tender duty.

Propulsion

Power comes from twin 2017 Verado outboards, each rated at 350 hp for a combined 700 hp of responsive thrust. Both engines run on gasoline in an outboard configuration and show approximately 1149 hours each, with perfect compression that reflects diligent care. Confidence is further elevated by fresh rebuilds on both lower units, showing 0 hours, so the bite at the prop feels factory – crisp and ready to run.

Specifications

Performance and proportions are squarely in the sweet spot: a cruising speed of 34.76 kn and a top speed of 52.14 kn sit atop a 33 ft length overall and an 11 ft beam, creating a fast, stable platform with room to breathe. The hull is fiberglass with a Deep Vee profile that parts chop cleanly and tracks true. Onboard tankage includes fresh water, fuel, and a holding tank, supporting comfortable days and uncomplicated overnights without compromise.
