## OVERVIEW

This exceptional 2025 Yellowfin 34 Offshore arrives with a Dealer Blowout price, reduced from \$646,774 to \$560,000, and is offered complete with a Mercury extended warranty promotion that expands engine coverage to 7 years (a \$24,000 value). At no extra cost the boat has been enveloped in a full XPEL Marine protection package with ceramic coating—a \$30,000 upgrade—applied by an authorized XPEL dealer to shield hull and brightwork from UV, salt, stains, and abrasion, reduce upkeep and preserve a showroom gloss for seasons to come.

Built as a bluewater sportfisher and refined dayboat, the Yellowfin 34 Offshore is a 34'8" center console with a 10' beam, marrying a fish-first deck layout with nimble handling. Yellowfin's signature twin-step hull delivers efficient high-speed performance and a dry, composed ride offshore, keeping crew comfortable when conditions turn unsettled. Propulsion comes from Triple Mercury 400 V10 Verado outboards that supply serious thrust and a confident turn of speed; under favorable conditions expect an effortless cruise in the vicinity of 40 mph, with the range and economy befitting a performance-oriented fishing platform.

Every angler-oriented detail has been considered: a huge transom livewell to keep bait lively, abundant rod holders and macerated fishboxes for catch management, plus a dedicated tackle and rigging station integrated into the leaning post—along with all the Yellowfin-standard features tournament anglers rely upon. Comfort and usability extend forward, too; the redesigned console is fully lined and includes a drop-down section with space for a marine head, making long offshore runs or family outings civilized and convenient. Wide, uncluttered decks and intelligent storage configurations create room for guests to relax while you chase the bite.

A genuine luxury fishing yacht by design and a versatile bluewater dayboat in practice, this offshore sportfish center console also performs superbly as a capable superyacht tender, ready to serve whatever role your next voyage demands.

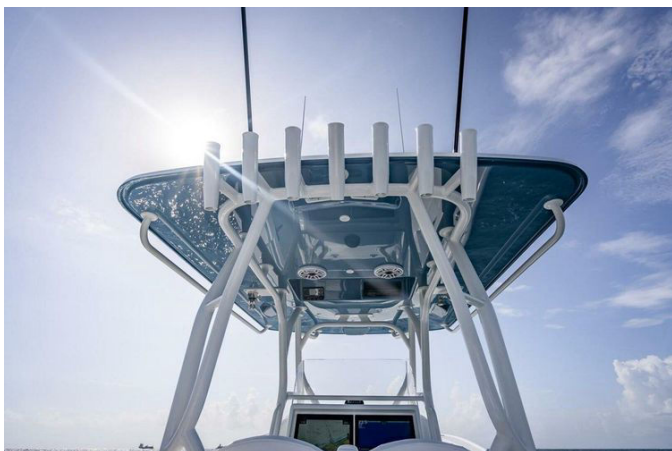

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Enhancements and convenience

---

Thoughtful upgrades elevate every moment on board, beginning with hose coil holders and both freshwater and saltwater washdowns that make cleanups instant and effortless, while power management is robust and redundant with both a two bank Pro charging station and a three bank Pro charging station, complemented by an extra Group 31 house battery for extended autonomy. After dark the yacht glows with two Shadowcaster multi color underwater lights and refined compartment courtesy lighting, and precise low speed control comes courtesy of a bow thruster. Long range independence is furthered by a SeaLand head with overboard discharge. Anchoring is streamlined by an electric anchor puller in drum style (no anchor), paired with a stainless steel plow package that supplies 475' of rope and 20' of chain for the windlass, and a forward liner anchor access door simplifies checks and service. Confidence for towing arrives with a dedicated tow eye package, exterior details are refined with powdercoated bowrails, and command remains intuitive via a miscellaneous eight switch pre labeled panel.

## Fishing accessory options

---

Purpose built angling enhancements await, starting with a commanding spread of eighteen titanium rodholders and eight rodholder-cupholder combos that keep every setup organized and at the ready. Boarding and handling are secure with a Garelick boarding ladder and transom grab rails. Live bait thrives under a dedicated livewell light, easy bilge visibility comes from bilge lights, and two Hubbell 30A electric reel outlets power deep drop tactics. Stowage is smart with two midship Rowan storage boxes, while a transom livewell window offers instant visual checks. System reliability is

anchored by a Best Marine seachest with two pumps, and fishbox pump outs are engineered with macerator and diaphragm solutions. Finishing the arsenal, gaff tubes keep tools protected and within reach.

## Electronics

---

Integrated helm technology inspires confidence and clarity, headlined by a Garmin 8617 MFD paired with a Garmin GSD26 sounder module and an Airmar B275LHW 1 kW BB transducer for wide band, deep water detail. A Garmin Fantom 256 open array radar paints the horizon, while precise course keeping is assured by a Mercury Electric Steer Autopilot. Weather and data stream seamlessly through a Garmin GXM 54 SiriusXM weather module and a Garmin card reader, and communication stays crystal clear with an Icom M510 VHF with relocation kit. Entertainment soars via a JL MM105 stereo driving eight JL Audio 7.7 coaxial speakers, four JL Audio 10 inch subwoofers, and two JL Audio Mv1000/5i amplifiers. Security and visibility are elevated with a GOST Nav Tracker 1.0 INS package and a Lumitec Razor 18 inch lightbar, while a Rokk charger keeps mobile devices topped up.

## Hardtop options

---

The hardtop inspires confidence with rear support legs and five RH standard, then steps up capability with two additional hardtop rodholders. A pair of hardtop running lights and five LED spreader lights cast purposeful illumination, complemented by multi color LED accent lighting. Offshore readiness is amplified by Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases mated to Gemlux 18' Bluewater External Black outriggers. A powdercoated hardtop with integrated grab rails and fingergrrips on pipework completes a secure, refined superstructure.

## Seating options and upholstery

---

Comfort and versatility converge at the helm and throughout the cockpit, starting with a medium leaning post fitted with four cup holders and a three open drawer tackle station, complemented by an aft side tackle station and a fold out trash can for tidy efficiency. Forward, seating without backrests maximizes deck space yet converts in moments with a table insert for relaxed lounging. A removable rear bench seat in a fifty/fifty configuration adds flexible capacity. The standard deluxe interior is elevated by the Mystic Hex stitching package, embroidered Yellowfin logos, and supportive Yellowfin helm seating that looks as compelling as it feels.

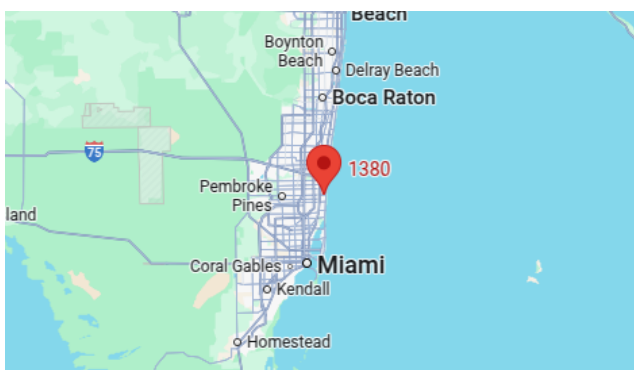
