OVERVIEW

The figure shown is offered as a guideline only, and thoughtful offers are cordially welcomed. Here is a 2006 American Tug 34, a sturdy Pacific Northwest-built pilothouse motor yacht prized for its steady seakeeping, economical single-diesel operation, and purposeful, expedition-minded demeanor. Equally at home as a coastal cruiser or a pocket trawler with tug-yacht lineage, she carries the structural promise of a refined liveaboard passagemaker and a Downeast-inspired trawler yacht, now presented as an engaging project for a buyer with an eye for restoration.

This 34-foot tug/trawler reportedly took on water during a hurricane; while she is believed to remain structurally sound, the vessel will require work to restore the swim platform, exterior gelcoat and topsides, interior joinery and cabinetry, and the installation of mechanical systems. The main engine, transmission, and a Northern Lights generator have each undergone comprehensive zero-hour rebuilds. Those rebuilt units are held by the shop that performed the work and are available separately, with running videos and detailed work orders obtainable on request from interested bidders. That arrangement permits a knowledgeable new owner to determine precisely how to complete and outfit the propulsion and auxiliary systems to their chosen specification, returning the yacht to her intended role as a capable coastal wanderer.

A trailer is not included in the sale. Nationwide transportation can be coordinated through a preferred marine carrier, with custom cradles fabricated as required and logistics organized for movement to ports for overseas shipment where necessary. Support for quotes and scheduling is readily provided, and trailer options may be sourced through the St. George, SC location if desired. For buyers seeking minimal friction in repositioning the vessel, comprehensive end-to-end solutions can be arranged to ensure a

smooth passage from acquisition to the refit yard.

Carefully note the machinery and condition disclaimers: no statement of condition is made or implied concerning any motors, engines, or onboard systems. Photographs may display engine spaces or components, but evaluation of those items remains the sole responsibility of the buyer.
