The 2024 Jupiter 34 HFS marries the comforts of a luxury dayboat with uncompromising sportfishing performance in an elegant center-console package. Conceived as a premium yacht tender, she delivers a smooth, gyro-stable ride and is equipped with a custom stainless towing eye and twin Cox CXO300 diesel outboards that can draw directly from the mothership's fuel supply. Purpose-built for extended, off-grid adventures, her efficient diesel power, ability to refuel from the tow vessel, and the refined fit and finish that define Jupiter make her equally at home as an offshore bluewater performer or a sophisticated tender.

Thoughtful features are seamlessly integrated into her design: an electric windlass with stainless anchor and rode; Release Marine teak backrests for forward seating; a fold-away transom jump seat and a mezzanine bench with livewell; a single underwater LED light; upgraded cup holders on two added pairs of 30° bow gunwale rod holders plus a transom-mounted rod holder. Practical comforts include a molded glovebox with dual USB charging ports, magnetic compass, Edson black steering wheel, easy-access door to the head compartment, and a dedicated helm electronics locker. Additional appointments are an 85-quart molded, insulated drink cooler, acrylic windscreen, 12V power outlet, oversized custom console with stand-up head, Bomar vent hatch, molded sink with pullout sprayer, and a console sun-lounge cooler.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Manufacturer provided description

The Jupiter 34 HFS stands as one of the most magnetic center consoles afloat, its sleek profile demanding attention at the dock while a hull engineered for offshore respect promises confident passages. Purpose-built for a remarkably smooth, dry ride across a broad spectrum of sea states, this 34 HFS also invites personalization so every surface and system can reflect your individual preferences. The layout is rigorously thoughtful: it answers the exacting needs of a tournament angler with practical, race-ready ergonomics while simultaneously cocooning family and guests in generous space, modern comfort, and contemporary amenities that define today's refined boating lifestyle.

Vessel details

Bespoke touches elevate this 34 HFS with an unmistakably premium presence, beginning with two Release Marine teak bolster seats that set a refined tone at the helm and a custom towing bit engineered for confident tender duty. The underside of the fiberglass hardtop receives a custom Awlcraft finish, while Gem-Lux outriggers with deluxe carbon fiber poles underline the boat's bluewater pedigree. Practicality meets polish in a port-side inward-opening dive door and refined gray upholstery stitched in elegant diamond quilting with tailored piping to complement the overall aesthetic. The electronics suite is curated for total command: twin Garmin 8616 multifunction displays are flush-mounted in a seamless glass helm and paired with a Fusion Apollo WB670 head unit plus an ERX 400 remote for intuitive audio control, while a JL Audio speaker and amplifier package envelopes the cockpit with rich, balanced sound via four 8.8-inch cockpit coaxial speakers, four 6.5-inch cockpit coaxial

speakers, and two 10-inch marine subwoofers driven by one 600-watt four-channel amplifier and one 900-watt five-channel amplifier, all supported by an eight-foot digital AM/FM antenna. Offshore awareness is anchored by a Garmin four-foot open-array radar while Seakeeper Ride refines running attitude and comfort underway. Forward, a lounge layout with teak-accent armrests invites relaxation and the mezzanine seating integrates a livewell for instant fish-to-cockpit efficiency, complemented by an electric freshwater marine head with holding tank and macerator overboard discharge for welcome autonomy. Fishing and storage capacity are serious and thoughtfully arranged: four rod holders, four pairs of rod racks, and two lockable rod storage lockers of seven cubic feet are augmented by dedicated safety-equipment storage, two 104-gallon fishboxes with macerator drains, and forward handrails for secure movement at sea. Systems are engineered for reliability and longevity, with two 2000 GPH bilge pumps offering automatic and manual modes paired with a high-water bilge alarm, a self-bailing non-skid cockpit, and a custom T-top with fiberglass hardtop that incorporates an overhead electronics box and molded fiberglass handrails to port and starboard, illuminated by Lumitec Mirage Spectrum lighting. Courtesy lighting in the console, RGBW under-gunwale lighting, and RGBW lighting in storage boxes create a sophisticated nighttime ambiance, while freshwater and raw/saltwater washdowns simplify cleanup and a boarding ladder with grab rail plus a walk-through transom door streamline access. A top-loading anchor locker stands ready at the bow and soft coaming bolsters ease long offshore days. The build is uncompromising: all fasteners, hinges, and hardware are stainless steel with flush-mounted deck fittings for a clean, snag-free perimeter; below the waterline bronze thru-hull fittings, seacocks on all penetrations, and double stainless-steel hose clamps reinforce safety. Fuel delivery is protected by ten-micron fuel filters/water separators feeding epoxy-coated, heavy-duty marine aluminum tanks that meet EPA compliance, and a heavy-duty vinyl rub rail with stainless-steel insert guards the hull at the

dock while molded fiberglass, gasketed hatches keep gear dry. Additional storage includes a 13 cubic foot forward compartment and two 11 cubic foot compartments plus a freshwater tank with gauge to monitor reserves. The electrical architecture is equally robust: all wiring is tinned copper, color-coded and numbered within a bonded electrical system with comprehensive circuit protection, managed by an automatic battery management system with a multi-bank charger, vapor-proof battery switches, a battery parallel switch for redundancy, and AGM heavy-duty marine batteries. The helm feels right in hand with an Edson black steering wheel, and onboard systems are simplified through EmpirBus digital switching for intuitive control of the vessel's many integrated functions.
