## OVERVIEW

---

### 2020 34' Performance Outboard — United States

Built to excite yet easy to own, this 2020, 34-foot performance yacht marries speed, poise, and practicality in a graceful, sea worthy composition. A broad 11 foot beam riding on a robust fiberglass composite hull and deck gives the vessel the calm confidence and presence of a larger craft while preserving nimble, responsive handling. Propelled by triple Mercury outboards, the yacht accelerates with lively authority, settling into a comfortable cruise at approximately 37 knots and capable of reaching an exhilarating 46 knots when the occasion demands.

Stepping aboard reveals an expansive deck arrangement conceived for leisurely days and effortless entertaining. Smooth, non skid fiberglass surfaces are both handsome and functional, framing a sociable cockpit that invites conversation whether underway or at anchor. The helm is laid out with careful ergonomic attention so that every control falls naturally to hand, while wide side decks, dependable grab rails, and unobstructed sightlines instill confidence when maneuvering at speed or alongside a dock.

Equipped for spirited passagemaking, the yacht carries 400 gallons of fuel to support extended runs and offshore exploration, and 45 gallons of freshwater to rinse off after swims and maintain comfort throughout the day. An enclosed head adds a layer of convenience and privacy for family and guests, making long, fast hops or impromptu coastal cruises genuinely comfortable. A 6.0 foot draft contributes to offshore capability and a reassuring motion in variable seas, reinforcing the boat's purposeful cruising character.

The lines are simultaneously timeless and athletic, with a low maintenance hull and deck finished in premium materials that resist sun and salt.

Underway, the triple Mercury outboards deliver the immediate throttle response experienced captains expect, yet remain approachable for newer

owners. Gas/petrol propulsion keeps servicing straightforward and ensures broad support across the United States.

For buyers seeking the ideal balance between a luxurious dayboat and a serious offshore performer, this 34 footer responds with composure, comfort, and unmistakable speed. It shines chasing horizons, hosting friends for a sunset harbor run, or making fast passages to favored fishing grounds, an agile companion that elevates every outing into an occasion. A compelling option for aficionados considering center console, offshore sportfish, express cruiser, performance dayboat, or tender categories, backed by durable fiberglass construction and the proven reliability of triple Mercury outboards.

## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### Exterior

---

A trio of Mercury Verado JPO 350 hp outboards with just 200 hours—specified as an upgrade—deliver commanding performance and joystick precision, complemented by an upgraded engine flush system that simplifies care after every run. The hardtop crowns the profile with a full-height windshield and opening tempered side glass, while two opening deck hatches integrated into the hardtop invite sea breezes. Navigating forward feels secure thanks to a dedicated handhold along the hardtop for egress to the foredeck and another handhold integrated into the helm deck area, with convenient ladder access to the hardtop itself. After dusk, an upgraded hardtop spotlight and four blue underwater LED lights set an elegant nocturnal scene. Outrigger-ready by design, the boat is poised for serious trolling from day one. The white hull, white rubrail with stainless-steel insert, and chrome graphics with a silver stripe underscore a crisp, enduring aesthetic that is pure Boston Whaler.

### Cockpit

---

The cockpit flexes effortlessly from bluewater action to refined relaxation. Upgraded fold-out bench seating to port and starboard disappears when it's time to fish and reappears to welcome guests. An upgraded cockpit table, cleverly stowable on the underside of the mechanical hatch, transforms the area into a gracious alfresco dining space, complemented by upgraded black canvas covers that protect your investment between adventures. Swimmers appreciate the covered telescoping swim ladder with stainless-steel grab rail, while a freshwater transom shower with hot and cold water refreshes after a dip. A robust 1.5" acrylic transom door with stainless-steel latch provides secure passage. Anglers are well served by three transom-mounted and four

gunnel mounted stainless steel rod holders, while blue LED courtesy lighting casts an atmospheric glow for evening passages.

## Starboard cockpit wet bar

---

Entertaining is intuitive at the starboard wet bar, where a hinged solid-surface lid reveals a recessed, insulated cooler below. Integrated cup holders and a dedicated storage compartment keep essentials neatly in place, while a pull out drawer on the starboard wall secures a five gallon pail for effortless cleanup. A refrigerator/freezer, plus a sink with a pull out hot and cold faucet, elevates service, and the FUSION stereo remote keeps the soundtrack perfectly tuned.

## Portside cockpit prep area

---

Opposite, the portside prep center streamlines culinary moments with a pull out solid surface worktop and a hinged cutting board above organized storage. A Kenyon electric grill brings sizzle to the sea, with a dedicated cooler bay on a slide for quick access, two drawers for utensils, and a thoughtful pull out footrest that makes the aft facing seat even more comfortable.

## Helm

---

Confidence at the helm comes courtesy of two 16" Raymarine Axiom XL displays integrating GPS, chart plotting, and fishfinding, paired with a Raymarine RV 1000 sounder and a Raymarine Ray63 VHF radio with wireless handset. A Navionics chart card for North America/Canada ensures detailed cartography. Mercury DTS dual binnacle controls and a Mercury SmartCraft VesselView 7" display keep the triple outboards perfectly synchronized, while trim tab control, a compass, and an electrical switch panel with illuminated text

make command intuitive day or night. Security and comfort are built in with a Theft Deterrence System, a tilt steering wheel, and a starboard helm seat with flip up bolster, armrests, a premium pedestal, and rotational adjustability. Climate is carefully managed with two AC vents for defrost and four AC vents directed to passengers and driver. Thoughtful touches include two cup holders, a locking glove box with courtesy LED light, and protective black canvas covers.

## Forward berth

---

Step below through a secure, lockable cabin door into a serene V berth dinette that rises and lowers electrically around a high gloss wood table, with generous storage beneath the seats. By night, the V berth seating converts into a true queen island bed, illuminated by two focused reading lights. An opening hatch with a solar shade and sky screen welcomes light and air on demand, while a carbon monoxide detector stands vigilant for peace of mind.

## Kitchenette

---

The well-equipped kitchenette elevates life aboard with an upgraded electric single burner stove, complemented by a coffee maker and a microwave for effortless morning rituals and quick meals. A sink with hot and cold faucet partners with a refrigerator/freezer and a discreet trash receptacle to keep the space tidy. Wood grain finish cabinets maximize organized stowage, and a cedar lined hanging locker preserves garments in freshness.

## Head

---

The private head is bright and practical, featuring a full length mirror and LED overhead lighting. A vanity with a porcelain sink and hot and cold faucet sits

opposite powered ventilation and a pull out showerhead with mixer valve, draining efficiently through an 800 GPH shower sump behind a convenient shower curtain. Accessories include a towel bar and ring, soap holder, and toilet paper holder, while the VacuFlush toilet system with holding tank, dockside pump out, overboard discharge, and tank level indicator assures clean, dependable operation. A skylight adds a final touch of natural brightness.

## Mid-berth

---

Amidships, a versatile U shaped lounge converts quickly to a comfortable berth, lit by two reading lights. The hardwood cabin sole lends a warm, yacht quality feel, and a privacy curtain offers a restful retreat at anchor.

## Starboard settee

---

To starboard, the settee expands your overnight options by converting into a double berth. Six rod holders are thoughtfully integrated so your tackle stays organized and protected, while a TV adds effortless entertainment below.

## Bow

---

Forward, the bow anchor locker is cleanly finished with drains and LED lighting, plus a freshwater washdown featuring a stainless steel faucet neatly housed inside the locker for efficient ground tackle maintenance.

## Av

---

Sound comes alive through a Fusion stereo system, delivering clear, powerful audio throughout the boat with fingertip control from the wet bar.

## Description

---

Two Roses is a 2020 Boston Whaler 345 Conquest celebrated for her sleek deep V hull and wide beam. Powered by triple Mercury Verado 350 hp engines, she moves seamlessly from saltwater fishing to sophisticated entertaining, with confidence inspired by cutting edge helm technology and a wealth of well placed fishing amenities for successful offshore runs in a variety of conditions. Premium, fully adjustable seating transforms the cockpit into a gracious alfresco dining space, while a well appointed, lockable cabin—with convertible seating that forms a queen and a double berth—plus an enclosed head, invites comfortable overnights. Rod storage within the cabin keeps tackle secure and out of harm's way whenever the sea calls for a smooth, enclosed ride.

## Highlights

---

Triple Mercury Verado JPO 350 hp engines with 200 hrs headline the specification, joined by a Westerbeke 7.5KW generator showing 150 hrs to keep creature comforts humming at anchor. In the cockpit, fold out bench seating to port and starboard and a stowable teak table adapt instantly from fishing to entertaining, while the prep area with Kenyon electric grill and the wet bar with sink, refrigerator, and freezer elevate on deck dining. Below, a lockable cabin with head supports true cruising, with a convertible forward berth forming a queen and the starboard settee converting to a double for family or guests. Anglers benefit from three transom mounted and four gunnel mounted stainless steel rod holders, along with four blue underwater

LED lights that dramatize the waterline after dark. Black canvas covers preserve finishes between voyages. Lift kept under a covered slip and showing no bottom paint, Two Roses presents cleanly and proudly.

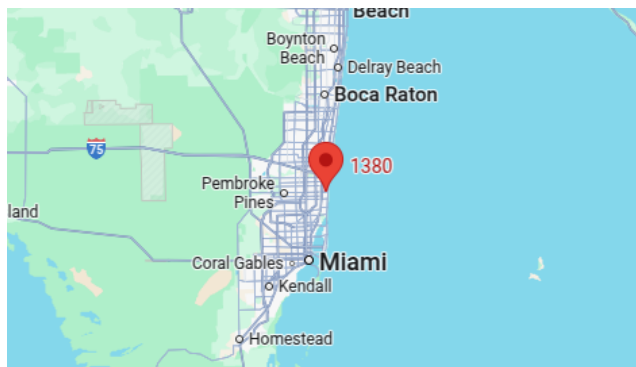
