DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent upgrades 2026

All onboard electronics were renewed in 2026 with the latest 2026-specification systems, and connectivity was significantly enhanced through the addition of a Starlink installation. A custom, five-piece Eisenglass enclosure was fitted to improve protection and visibility at the helm, while onboard comfort was revisited with bespoke cushions and fresh upholstery for the aft bench, backrest and forward seating. Operational capability has been bolstered by newly fitted 22-foot carbon-fiber outriggers, and comprehensive engine servicing was carried out in November 2025 and again in April 2026, with complete service records available.

Layout and accommodations

Designed specifically for offshore fishing, the layout centers on a luxurious helm seat, dedicated forward console seating, and a removable aft bench that transforms the cockpit to suit a variety of missions. The walk-in console conceals a full stand-up head and separate shower, thoughtfully paired with a sink and freshwater supply to ensure comfort underway. Ample, intelligently positioned storage compartments are integrated throughout the vessel, offering organized, easy access to gear and essentials.

Engine - twins

Propulsion is provided by a matched pair of 2016 Mercury Verado 350 outboards, each rated at 350 hp and equipped with four-blade propellers that improve grip and propulsive efficiency. With approximately 975 hours recorded on each engine, the twin-outboard layout delivers a combined 700

hp, resulting in assured, responsive acceleration and composed handling across a range of sea conditions.

Tankage

A single 300-gallon fuel tank, situated below deck, supplies substantial range and endurance; paired with 50 gallons of fresh water and an 11-gallon holding tank, the tankage arrangement delivers the autonomy and onboard comfort desired for extended cruising.

Electronics

New for 2026, the helm has been thoughtfully upgraded with two Garmin GPSMAP 8612xsv 12-inch multifunction displays, complemented by a Garmin B275LHW transducer and a Garmin GMR 24 xHD3 radar—24 inches, 4 kW—securely installed on a Seaview modular radar mount with the Seaview ADA-R1 radar adapter plate. Accurate positioning is provided by a Garmin GPS 24xd NMEA 2000 antenna, while steering and course-keeping are entrusted to a Garmin Reactor 40 CorePump autopilot; a SIONYX Nightwave low-light marine camera enhances visibility in dim conditions. Onboard entertainment is delivered through a Fusion MS-RA670 Apollo marine stereo driving a JL Audio M3 7.7-inch marine speaker, and dependable communication and power provisioning are ensured by a Shakespeare 5225XT Galaxy 8-foot VHF antenna, a Blue Sea Systems dual USB charging outlet, a bespoke black acrylic helm panel, and a complete NMEA 2000 cable kit.

Audio

A Fusion MS-RA 670 Apollo marine stereo teams with a JL Audio M3 7.7-inch marine speaker to create an immersive onboard soundscape, delivering

pristine, resonant audio engineered for the challenges of the marine environment—offering crisp clarity under way and a refined, enveloping ambiance when at anchor.

Deck & mechanical

The yacht's expansive open center-console design invites effortless movement, with broad side decks and full 360-degree walkaround access that ensure secure, graceful transit from bow to stern. A forward console cooler and helm seating with integrated storage add refined convenience, while aft bench seat cushions and a transom door facilitate easy boarding and relaxed aft lounging. Functionality is provided by both freshwater and saltwater washdown systems and a dedicated anchor locker, and onboard comfort was enhanced with new cushions installed in 2026.

Performance

Built to thrill on both spirited hops and extended voyages, this yacht is estimated to cruise at approximately 33 knots at approximately 4,500 RPM, while its peak capability is estimated at approximately 42 knots at approximately 5,600 RPM with the throttles fully open (wide-open throttle, WOT). These performance figures are approximate and will vary with vessel load, fuel level, sea conditions, propeller selection, engine condition and other operating factors, and actual performance should be verified during a sea trial.

Fishing

Every detail aboard is conceived for the discerning angler: a combined 400-gallon capacity of insulated in-deck fish boxes maintains your catch at optimal chill, while ample rod holders and intelligently arranged tackle storage

keep lines, lures and equipment secure and instantly to hand. Dual freshwater and saltwater washdown systems make post-fight cleanups effortless, and twenty-two-foot carbon-fiber outriggers unfurl a broad, commanding spread to enhance your trolling performance. Strategically placed 2026 Outlets 12V-PTS deliver dedicated 12V connections exactly where you need reliable power for your gear.

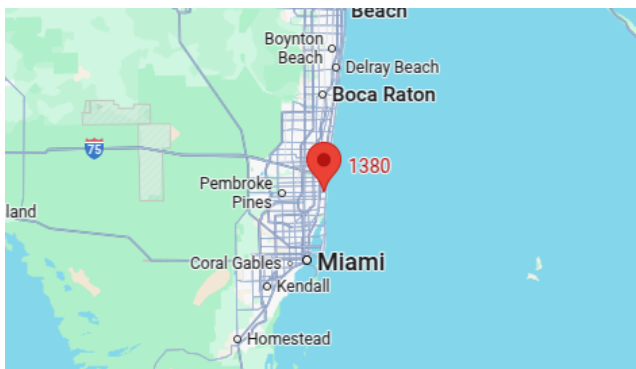
