Fitted out with the comforts and layout of a luxury center console, she features a Garmin touchscreen suite and a FLIR thermal-imaging camera for confident navigation, and is equipped with both bow and stern thrusters to ensure effortless docking and precise handling. Meticulously maintained and genuinely turn-key, this boat spent six seasons in the brackish waters of the Western Chesapeake Bay, was wintered indoors and kept out of the water. With fresh bottom paint and a regularly waxed gloss, this offshore dayboat and sportfishing cruiser offers true bluewater poise ready to enhance your next voyage.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Standard equipment

From stem to stern the standard specification is uncompromising: dual swim platforms with a center walk through welcome you aboard, where hydraulic steering with power assist and an Armstrong dive swim ladder complement the secure transom door. A 60 gallon transom fish box/storage sits aft and is paired with 10" pull up stern and bow cleats, two spring line 8" cleats, six stainless steel flush mount gunnel rod holders, and four horizontal under gunnel rod storage racks to keep tackle ready and organized. An aft under deck systems station with dedicated storage keeps service access tidy, while 30 amp shore power with a 50' cord and a 50 amp battery charger manage ship's power needs. Clever stowage continues with a port aft side transom storage compartment and port and starboard aft floor fish boxes, and washdowns are effortless via raw and fresh water feeds served by a 30 gallon tank. Comfort and fishability converge at the aft facing stern seat with an underside bait well, tackle drawers, cup holders, and armrests, while dual adjustable Airmar custom helm chairs with folding lean bolsters and armrests command the cockpit. Everyday essentials tuck neatly into the glove box, and underside tackle storage drawers combine with a four bank battery compartment to keep gear and energy reserves perfectly ordered.

Helm

At the helm, entertainment and control are seamless: a Kenwood stereo system ready for an iPod plug or USB flash drive energizes four JL Audio 7.7 component speakers through a JL Audio 450 watt amp, delivering crisp sound underway. The powder coated, patented T Top hardtop with glass enclosure shelters the command center and is complemented by an electric center top

vent for fresh airflow. Operation is intuitive via a switch panel with lighted switches, a console glove box with a 12V plug, and a precise compass, while visibility and safety extend into the night with courtesy and navigation lights, molded in forward and aft spreader lights, and remote lights that put illumination exactly where you need it.

Inner console berth

Step inside the inner console berth to find a thoughtfully appointed retreat: a microwave and an ice chest set beneath a Corian counter enable quick provisioning, while a stainless steel sink set in a Corian vanity with mirror elevates day to day convenience. The marine head features electric overboard discharge and a 10 gallon holding tank for self contained comfort, overhead lights brighten the space, port and starboard windows admit natural light, and a double berth with a fold up table transforms from lounge to sleeping quarters with ease.

Hull, deck, and cockpit

On deck every surface works as hard as it shines: a starboard console storage closet neatly stows brush, gaff, lines, and more, while 360 degree bolster cushions and a recessed powder coated coaming rail add security and refinement. The stepped hull delivers efficient, confident performance. Forward, a console double sun deck lounge with cushions, armrests, and underside storage invites relaxation, complemented by forward bow seating with underside storage and a cooler. Ground tackle is handled by a Lewmar windlass with anchor, chain, and rode, complete with bow foot controls and helm controls, and additional bow under deck storage expands capacity. A 12 V refrigerator keeps provisions chilled for the journey.
