The Boston Whaler 350 Outrage stands as a premier offshore fishing vessel, seamlessly blending robust performance with luxurious seating and entertainment options. This crossover center console has gained immense popularity, catering to a variety of activities on the water. At the forefront, a spacious doublewide lounge seat is equipped with armrests, drink holders, and a generous lockable storage compartment beneath. An adjustable table transforms the bow area into an expansive sun pad, perfect for relaxation. For those who love to entertain, the optional "Summer Kitchen" replaces traditional tackle storage with an electric grill and inverter, enhancing your onboard experience.

A notable addition is the portside dive door, which facilitates effortless access to the dock or water. The cockpit features a standard foldaway transom seat, while the roomy head compartment is outfitted with a VacuFlush toilet, sink, and pullout shower for added convenience. Other highlights include a fiberglass hardtop integrated into the console, a deluxe leaning post with a bait prep center, a freshwater sink, and a 40-gallon livewell, alongside a 23-gallon aft livewell and five transom rod holders. The helm boasts three-across seating with flip-up bolsters, and an upper control station is available as an option. Powered by triple Mercury Verado 300hp outboards, this yacht achieves exhilarating speeds of over 45 knots.
