OVERVIEW

Built in 2007 by the renowned Spanish yard Astondoa, this Astondoa 53 express sport yacht stands proudly among express cruisers and motor yachts, embodying three generations of shipbuilding expertise that began with the brand's first launch in 1916. That long heritage is evident in every seam and surface, where meticulous craftsmanship meets forward looking European lines to create a genuine luxury yacht ambience. Arranged for expansive, free flowing living, the 53 delivers generous exterior decks and commodious interior volume while deliberately avoiding higher maintenance pod drives, an engineering choice that favors reliability and ease of ownership. The open plan arrangement unfolds into three spacious staterooms and an interior finished with refined appointments, all set within a performance oriented hull engineered to exceed 30 knots, marrying the exhilaration of a performance yacht with the sociable openness of an open yacht. This specific vessel has been attentively maintained and presents in exceptionally clean condition, benefitting from continual, considerate upgrades by her owner. Ready for immediate inspection, she awaits the next steward eager for a Mediterranean style sport cruiser that combines pedigree, performance, and thoughtful practicality.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Notable features and upgrades

Impeccably maintained and thoughtfully modernized, this yacht benefits from new bow thruster and engine start batteries installed in 2025 and shows only 679 hours on her Common Rail MAN engines as of 11/25, with the comprehensive MAN one thousand hour service completed on both engines and the generator in 10/24; navigation and communications have been refreshed with a new Garmin 5212 multifunction display, new VHF and AIS, a new autopilot, a new echosounder, and a new aft camera. Her teak deck was resealed in 2025, all smart TVs are new, and the cockpit now features a new refrigerator and a new microwave for effortless entertaining, while she is offered with a 2019 Highfield CL340 Aluminum Tender and enhanced exterior comfort thanks to new bow cushions installed in 8/18 and new cockpit canvas with fly screens. The interior ambiance is elevated by upgraded LED lighting and beautifully refinished interior woodwork across the siding, ceilings, and salon, safety is reinforced with a new Sea Fire system and fresh anodes fitted in 2025, and performance and reliability are further assured with reconditioned propellers, new hydraulics servicing both the swim platform and the sunroof, and the convenience of a tender garage. Climate control has been thoroughly updated with two new A/C units for the main salon and master stateroom installed in 8/16, a new cockpit A/C unit in 11/16, and a new A/C unit in the guest cabin in 8/17, complemented by crisp, powerful entertainment from updated Fusion head units, two amplifiers, and six JL 700 marine speakers, and rounded out by a new Dometic freshwater pump, fresh antifouling paint, and a new floor in the lower salon following an extensive refit.

Additional information

Purpose built for open air living, the cockpit features two new AC units installed in 2018, a sun pad in mocha leather, and a new LED TV beneath a hard top with a hydraulic sunroof, while three single pilot seats in matching mocha leather face forward and transom gate style doors, a versatile hi/lo table, and an inviting L shaped settee create a sociable lounge. Entertainment is at your fingertips with Fusion audio control and JL Audio speakers, and the wet bar suite includes a Summit stove with two burners, a stainless steel sink, and a U Line ice maker, all served by a hydraulic swim platform and the convenience of a tender garage and passerelle; practical touches from fresh and raw water washdown to AC controls underline the vessel's readiness for leisurely gatherings and full time cruising, with a full interior refit completed in 2024 by Jarrett Bay adding modern finish and comfort.

Electronics

The helm is comprehensively outfitted with a new Garmin 5212 twelve inch multifunction display, M3 TracVision SAT TV, a Garmin HD radio antenna, and a Garmin enclosed array radar, all complemented by a new autopilot, while vital engine data is presented on dual MAN diesel engine displays and communications and situational awareness are sharpened by new VHF and AIS equipment. For precision and redundancy the suite adds an Artica compass, a Raymarine Tridata display, Vetus bow thruster control, trim tab control, and a combined fuel gauge with digital fuel meter, and entertainment and depth awareness are further enhanced by a Fusion radio head unit, a new echosounder, and a new aft camera to ensure confident navigation and guest comfort.

Salon

A bright and contemporary retreat, the salon boasts a new Samsung TV and central vacuum, with a starboard side cream leather sofa and a refined coffee table framed by stainless steel portholes, while comfort is immediate via dedicated AC controls and abundant storage to port and starboard keeps the space clutter free. An array of recessed overhead LED lights in metal housings sets a polished tone against oak wood veneer cabinetry, and after the 2024 Jarrett Bay refit the salon features new floors, ceiling, and interior siding complemented by tasteful blinds that complete this elegant haven.

Galley

Thoughtfully positioned to port, the galley is illuminated by recessed overhead LED lights with metal housings and outfitted for extended cruising with a new Summit full size refrigerator, a new Summit microwave, and a Summit cooktop with two burners, while a stainless sink basin with faucet makes preparation seamless and blinds provide privacy and light control for an efficient and comfortable culinary space.

Master stateroom - located forward

The forward master stateroom is a cocoon of comfort, with a new Samsung TV and leather wrapped bed accents surrounding a centerline berth with custom cover and headboard, while natural light filters through stainless steel portholes and an escape hatch balanced by blinds and recessed overhead LED lights. Climate is easily managed via AC controls, storage is generous with oak veneer cabinetry and two hanging lockers to port and starboard, and a private ensuite head completes this refined retreat.

Master head

Finely appointed with a granite countertop and matching granite flooring, the master head includes a sink, oak wood veneer cabinetry, and a mirror with medicine cabinet style storage, while a stainless steel porthole brings in light and an enclosed shower offers a warm, private sanctuary at sea.

VIP stateroom - located aft and to starboard

Nestled aft to starboard, the VIP stateroom features a double berth dressed in custom bedding, a hanging locker, and upgraded recessed overhead LED lights, while stainless steel portholes invite daylight, AC controls tailor the climate, and oak wood veneer cabinetry provides a warm, contemporary finish for guests to enjoy refined comfort.

Guest stateroom - located aft and to port

Aft to port, the guest stateroom offers a twin bunk sleeping two with custom bedding and both a hanging locker and additional hanging lockers for flexible storage, while stainless steel portholes, upgraded recessed overhead LED lights, AC controls, and oak wood veneer cabinetry ensure guests enjoy the same level of comfort and finish found throughout the yacht.

Electrical/mechanical systems

Engineering is robust and recently serviced, with a Kohler generator showing 600 hours, a ProNautic battery charger, and Glendinning cable master with cord tub, while safety is addressed by a fire suppression system and the one thousand hour service on engines and generator was completed in October 2024. Daily living is supported by a water heater, a new Dometic freshwater

pump, new engine start and bow thruster batteries, and a new fuel sender for accurate readings, alongside a well specified air conditioning system and comprehensive mechanical updates that prioritize reliability and ease of ownership.

Foredeck & deck equipment

Deck circulation is effortless via side walk forward access with a teak sole, protected by robust rub rails and guided by navigation lights, while forward a sunpad is paired with two JL Audio speakers and ground tackle is handled by a LoFrans electric windlass. Thoughtful touches include cup holders, additional JL Audio speakers, a stainless steel bow rail with safety line, stainless cleats and hawse pipes, windshield wipers, and freshwater windshield washers; recent mechanical updates include new hydraulics for the swim platform and sunroof, plus new canvas and fly screens, new bow cushions, and a resealed teak deck in 2025, with underwater protection and longevity ensured by new anodes in 2025 and fresh antifouling paint.

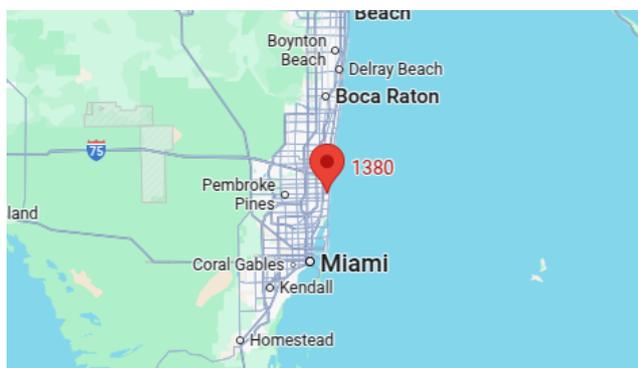
