OVERVIEW

Propelled by a pair of Yamaha 300 outboards, this luxury center-console combines exhilarating performance with refined handling courtesy of an integrated bow thruster. Hydrodynamic trim is managed by Lectrotab trim tabs, navigation is entrusted to three Simrad GPS units, and onboard communications are provided by a Garmin VHF, all assembled within an impeccably appointed center-console.

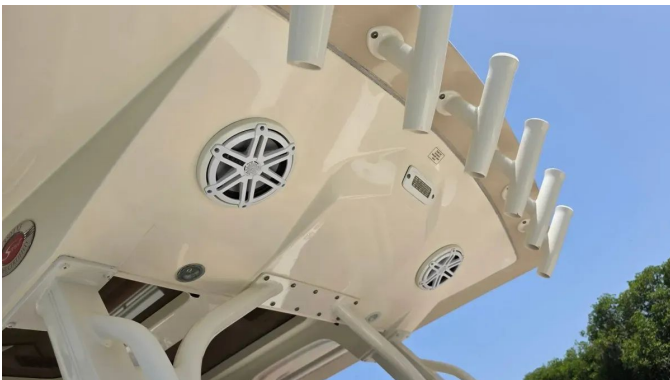

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2017 Scout 350 LXF

Designed to deliver serene days and assured passages, this 2017 Scout 350 LXF rests on a stepped hull and is surrounded by 360-degree bolster cushions and a recessed, powder-coated coaming rail that combine to provide both luxury and security underway. The starboard console conceals a dedicated storage closet for brushes, gaffs, lines and other gear, while forward the console hosts a double sundeck lounge finished with plush cushions, armrests and substantial underside storage that complements bow seating which hides additional lockers and a built-in cooler. Under-deck stowage in the bow keeps equipment neatly out of sight, and anchoring is effortless with a Lewmar windlass supplied with anchor, chain and rode, controllable from bow foot switches or from the helm. For onboard refreshment a 12-volt refrigerator maintains chilled provisions.

The inner console berth is appointed for extended outings with practical, refined finishes: a microwave and an ice chest crowned by a Corian countertop, a stainless steel sink set into a Corian vanity with mirror, and a marine head featuring electric overboard discharge and a 10-gallon holding tank. Natural light filters through port and starboard windows, overhead lighting creates atmosphere after dusk, and a double berth with a fold-up table seamlessly converts from a lounging area to a dining space when required.

At the helm luxury meets functionality with a Kenwood stereo that accepts an iPod connection or USB flash drive and drives four JL Audio 7.7 component speakers powered by a JL Audio 450-watt amplifier for rich, open-water sound. A powder-coated, patented T-top hardtop with glass enclosure and an electric center-top vent shelters the helm, which is equipped with a lighted-switch panel, a console glove box with a 12-volt outlet and a compass. Visibility and

safety are enhanced by courtesy and navigation lights, molded-in forward and aft spreader lights and remote-controlled lighting.

The standard equipment package is comprehensive and thoughtfully arranged: dual swim platforms with a center walk-through and an Armstrong dive swim ladder plus a secure transom door provide effortless water access; a 60-gallon transom fish box offers ample fish storage; 10-inch pull-up cleats fore and aft and two 8-inch spring-line cleats manage docking loads; six stainless steel flush-mount gunwale rod holders and four horizontal under-gunwale rod storage spaces support serious fishing. Systems are centralized with an aft under-deck systems station and storage, and shore power is provided via a 30-amp connection with a 50-foot cord and backed by a 50-amp battery charger. Additional stowage includes port aft-side transom lockers and port and starboard aft floor fish boxes, while cleanup is simplified by raw and fresh water washdown served from a 30-gallon tank. Cockpit comfort is assured by an aft-facing stern seat with an underside bait well and tackle drawers, complemented by cup holders and armrests, and by dual adjustable Airmar custom helm chairs with folding lean bolsters, armrests and an integrated glove box. Underside tackle storage drawers and a four-bank battery compartment keep rods, lures and power organized and ready for every excursion.

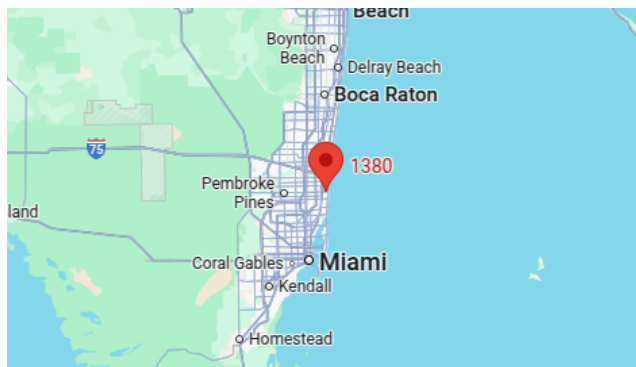
