





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Lightly used, properly maintained, and poised for coastal cruising, club racing, or relaxed weekend sailing, this well-presented yacht blends performance and comfort with rare finesse, offering a spacious cockpit, a functional deck layout, and a bright interior that set the tone while her Farr Yacht Design hull remains fast, stable, and delightfully responsive; the sail inventory is strong and complemented by thoughtful deck ergonomics, the three-cabin layout with a generous salon makes life aboard effortless, the reliable Volvo diesel rated at 20 HP ensures confidence, and her clean overall condition supports robust resale value—an ideal platform for club racing, coastal cruising, or daysailing without compromise. With an LOA of 36'7" (11.15 m), a beam of 12'3" (3.74 m), and a draft of 7'3" (2.20 m), she carries a displacement of approximately 12,600 lbs with about 4,200 lbs of lead ballast in a fin keel for a superb blend of stiffness and speed; the fiberglass hull, dual wheel steering, and the pedigree of Farr Yacht Design all align under the banner of Beneteau craftsmanship in this 2004 build that continues to present smartly and sail beautifully. Her mechanical heart is a Volvo diesel driving through a saildrive on diesel fuel with an approximate 20-gallon fuel tank for practical range, freshwater cooling to support longevity, and a propeller that is either folding or fixed (to be verified onboard), offering efficiency under power alongside minimal drag under sail. Sail handling is straightforward and race-ready with an aluminum mast and boom in a fractional sloop rig, stainless steel standing rigging, and running rigging reported in good condition; a mainsail, genoa/jib, and spinnaker cover the wind range, an adjustable backstay refines trim, and a deck-stepped mast simplifies service while maintaining performance. On deck, teak cockpit seating in select areas adds warmth and grip, non-skid decks inspire confidence, and

stainless steel lifelines and stanchions provide security, while an anchor stands ready for quiet nights, self-tailing winches streamline trimming, a swim ladder invites spontaneous swims, and large cockpit locker storage keeps gear organized and accessible. Electronics and navigation are thoughtfully equipped with a chartplotter, depth sounder, speed/log, wind instrument, VHF radio, and a compass, with electronics brands and models to be verified onboard, ensuring a clear path ahead whether racing the line or chasing horizons. Below, three private cabins and accommodations for eight create a versatile cruising and racing platform, the salon offers large U-shaped seating around a dining table for convivial meals, while the galley provides a stainless steel sink, stove/oven, refrigerator, and ample storage cabinets; the head is fitted with a marine toilet, sink, and shower, and the teak-and-holly cabin sole, together with excellent natural light and ventilation, delivers an inviting, airy ambience. Electrical systems include a 12V DC system, shore power connection, a battery charger, and both house and engine batteries for reliable energy management alongside simple dockside convenience, and safety equipment is likewise comprehensive with bilge pumps manual and electric, fire extinguishers, navigation lights, and safety rails and jacklines rounding out a capable offshore-minded package. "Solitude" represents an excellent opportunity to own a high-performance Beneteau First 36.7 at a competitive price point—respected worldwide for build quality, speed, and versatility; she is turn-key for the season and ready for inspection, easy to show in Florida by appointment.
