OVERVIEW

NEW TO MARKET

36 ft 1998 Luhrs 36 Convertible — Fish Daddy

A purposeful offshore Sportfish with the soul of a comfortable cruiser, this 1998 Luhrs 36 Convertible—Fish Daddy—bridges tournament capability and family-friendly cruising with grace. She is driven by twin Caterpillar 3126 diesels, 420 HP each, with the port engine and transmission recently rebuilt to restore reliable bluewater performance. The flybridge is sheltered by a robust hardtop fitted with all-new Eisenglass, and an updated Raymarine electronics suite guides every passage. Tackle-ready appointments include outriggers, rocket launchers, and a generous cockpit arranged around a bait prep station with integrated livewell, while a tuna door and walk-through transom provide effortless access to the water. A self-bailing cockpit and dedicated freshwater/saltwater washdowns keep the deck shipshape during long days on the bite.

Belowdecks, refined cherry joinery warms the interior, which feels larger than her 36-foot footprint. Comfort systems include dual air conditioning units (16K & 7K BTU) and a Phasor 8 kW generator (approx. 689 hours) to run amenities at anchor. The fully equipped galley includes washer/dryer convenience, and accommodations consist of a private master stateroom and a separate stall shower for true liveaboard ease. Recent maintenance is highlighted by a bottom job completed approximately 1 year ago, making this turnkey Convertible Sportfish ready to fish or cruise without delay. Proven Luhrs design — feels bigger than 36 ft.




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Brokers walkthrough

This Luhrs 36 punches above its length, feeling bigger than 36 feet with confident volume and smart deck flow, and it presents to brokers as a capable, no-nonsense platform that balances fishing functionality with comfortable cruising. Inside, the ethos is purposeful rather than pretentious, a practical, hard-wearing interior designed to be lived in and fished hard, while the proven CAT 3126s supply muscular, long-legged performance with the kind of durability owners swear by; a newer Raymarine electronics suite sharpens navigation and fish-finding and fresh bottom work completed one year ago adds peace of mind and turn-key appeal.

Factory installed options

Thoughtful factory options elevate capability and comfort through practical upgrades that matter offshore and at the dock: climate control comes via two air-conditioning units rated at 16K and 7K, while an all-new full flybridge enclosure extends the season and protects the helm. Entertainment is anchored by a 15" flat-screen TV in the master stateroom and a flybridge stereo, and ship's power is backed by a Phasor 8 kW generator showing 689 hours. Offshore-minded details include rocket launchers, outriggers, internal sea strainers, and an Oil X-Change R oil changing system; shore water connection and spreader lights simplify dockside life, the electric windlass with deck controls streamlines anchoring, and under-gunnel courtesy lighting sets a refined evening ambiance.

Accommodations

The main salon sets a warm tone with a cherry finish, wood mini blinds, recessed overhead lighting, and a sofa dressed with designer cushions over generous under seat storage; a 40" flat screen TV and stereo anchor entertainment. The galley is fully equipped for extended cruising with an AC/DC refrigerator/freezer, a flush two burner AC cooktop, a built in microwave, a Corian countertop, courtesy lighting along the sole, hot and cold pressure water, recessed lighting, a stainless steel sink, and upper and lower cherry cabinets with drawers and abundant shelving; a washer/dryer combo, dishwasher, and ice maker elevate liveaboard convenience. The head is smartly appointed with an electric toilet with macerator, a flush mounted overhead ventilation hatch, a molded fiberglass cabinet beneath the vanity, recessed lighting, a separate stall shower with bi fold door, and a vanity topped in Corian. The master stateroom carries the cherry motif and offers two lighted cedar lined hanging lockers, a queen berth with three large drawers and additional under berth storage, fabric lined hull sides, an innerspring mattress, private reading lights, recessed overhead lighting, a soft headliner, stereo speakers, and a 15" TV with DVD player. The guest stateroom features a flush mounted overhead hatch, a large cedar lined hanging locker, private reading lights over the berth, and an updated layout with the lower berth removed to open up the space.

Flybridge

The flybridge invites long runs and socializing with bench seat cushions and an upholstered backrest, a molded stairway for sure footed access, and a commanding center console helm flanked by custom helm and companion chairs; a custom welded half tower integrates six rocket launchers for ready to reach rigs, while full engine instrumentation, hydraulic steering, a

large storage bay beneath the console, and proper navigation lights support confident operation in all conditions.

Electronics

At the bridge, navigation and awareness are state of the art with dual Raymarine Axiom 9" displays, a Raymarine 18" radar dome, and a Raymarine autopilot. Entertainment and comms are covered by a Sony Bluetooth stereo, VHF, and a Ritchie compass for reliable heading reference.

Electrical systems

Robust ship's power and protection come via a battery charger, battery safety switches, and a custom electrical panel with breaker switches, all tied together with a custom wire harness and color coded wiring throughout. A DC interior lighting system keeps consumption low, a dockside 240V connection and a 50 ft shore power cord simplify hookups, and the internal bonding system with GFCI protection throughout enhances safety at sea and at the dock.

Deck

On deck, anchoring and line handling are effortless with a Quick 1000 windlass, a bow pulpit with anchor roller, and an anchor cleat with safety latch. A molded anchor well with locker houses a 300 ft rode that is mostly chain, while forward, mid, and aft mooring cleats, a high density rub rail with stainless steel insert, and three custom flush mounted tinted ventilation hatches round out a seamanlike, resilient deck plan.

Cockpit/fishing features

Purpose built for anglers, the cockpit features under gunnel courtesy lighting

and both dockside water and raw water washdowns to keep decks spotless. A large coaming mounted fish box with removable double lids and an overboard drain swallows the day's catch, while a molded fiberglass portside bait prep center with tackle drawers, livewell, and sink streamlines the rhythm of rigging. Practical touches include a rudder access hatch, a self bailing cockpit with scuppers, and a walk through transom door for easy boarding and fish handling.

Mechanical systems

Engine room engineering centers on reliability: a Reverso oil change system, freshwater cooling on the engines, fuel/water separators, and a welded aluminum fuel tank simplify maintenance and extend component life. Safety and serviceability are enhanced by an engine alarm system, a Halon system, an engine room ladder, molded air intakes, recessed trim tabs, and a reverse polarity light. Three automatic/manual bilge pumps stand ready, and a water heater adds home style comfort after a day on the water.
