OVERVIEW

Immaculately maintained and richly appointed, the 2021 Everglades 365 Center Console named Baby Seal marries serious offshore performance with the comforts of a luxury family dayboat. Power comes from triple Yamaha 300s—still under their remaining warranty—integrated with Yamaha Helm Master EX joystick control and autopilot, and feeding three crisp Garmin touchscreens that place effortless command of the sea at the helm. With roughly 900 horsepower available she settles into a relaxed cruise in the mid to high 30 knot range and will sprint to approximately 60 mph on demand, delivering the predictable, confidence inspiring ride Everglades is famous for.

The command area presents three captain's chairs before a custom painted dash beneath a substantial hardtop and three sided enclosure, while forward the layout invites social life with lounge seating wrapped around a cocktail table, a spacious sunning pad, and a surprisingly roomy cabin that includes a proper china bowl head with macerator and holding tank under a teak cover, a sink, and a berth suitable for quick overnights. When fishing becomes the priority, the bow cushions lift to reveal an expansive casting deck, instantly converting this refined dayboat into a tournament ready saltwater machine. Kept indoors and dry since new, Baby Seal shows like the day she left the factory, complete with custom paint on hull, hardtop, and engines, and a premium JL/Fusion audio suite that fills the deck with rich, concert quality sound.

The console is conceived for both comfort and function, anchored by Everglades' patented hydraulic sliding windshield in tempered glass, complemented by an intelligent wiper/washer system to preserve clear sightlines in adverse conditions. Practical appointments include a glove box and a 20A 12V power port, a stainless steering wheel and molded fiberglass

footrest, and interior touches that read more like a cruiser than a center console: a mirror and Infinity flooring underfoot, a teak entry step, and a tidy storage locker with shelves and stainless keeper rails. A wood grain vanity with cabinet and solid surface countertop houses an understated sink with a pull out shower faucet, extending the boat's versatility for overnighting or rinsing off after a swim.

Above, the fiberglass hardtop is set on a powder coated aluminum frame and outfitted with LED lighting, four spreader lights, seven rod holders plus two kingfish holders, and a sturdy powder coated ladder—equally prepared for bluewater sportfishing or a relaxed sunset cruise. The Premier audio package centers on a Fusion 770 with Bluetooth, driving JL M Series speakers, an amplifier, and a subwoofer to create enveloping sound throughout the vessel.

Anchor and deck hardware are specified for serious use: ground tackle comprises a 300 foot 5/8 inch 8 plait rode mated to 15 feet of 5/16 inch chain with a swivel and anchor, while six 10 inch 316 stainless pull up cleats and recessed cockpit drains keep the cockpit tidy and secure. Low profile, powder coated bow and toe rails are joined by stainless drink holders and an anti fatigue helm pad available in mocha or storm gray. Boarding is effortless with a retractable transom boarding ladder and stainless grab rail, a transom gate with freeing port, and an inboard opening side utility door. The forward salon can be arranged around a high/low electric filler table, with forward console seating and convertible backrests at the bow; in the cockpit you'll find triple Pompanette helm seats with armrests, coaming bolsters, a folding stern bench, and a neat aft facing folding seat at the workstation. Thoughtful stowage—from abundant rod racks to a bilge net—keeps gear organized and within reach, affirming this boat's dual role as family cruiser and hard charging offshore center console.

Systems and safety are comprehensive and well protected. Automatic bilge pumps and a high water alarm add peace of mind, while LED illumination is

deployed where it matters—full spectrum accent lighting, anchor and navigation lights, docking and courtesy lights, and brilliant underwater LEDs for evenings at the sandbar or night fishing. A remote spotlight and electric horn enhance safety and convenience, and dual battery banks—separate engine start and house systems, each with charging—support extended cruising. Stainless dual cylinder trim tabs include position indicators and auto retract functionality, and a 50 foot 30 amp shore power cord with SmartPlug connectivity simplifies dockside power. Raw and fresh water washdowns make cleanup after a day on the bite quick and easy.

Beneath the finishing details resides Everglades' signature construction, delivering an unsinkable, NMMA certified platform backed by a lifetime hull warranty and three year component coverage. The variable deadrise deep V hull is fabricated using the patented RAMCAP closed mold process with high density, closed cell structural foam flotation, vinyl ester barrier coats, and knitted bi axial fiberglass for durability and longevity. The composite transom, fully finished hull liner, and deck are bonded into a rigid, one piece structure with molded diamond non skid underfoot, while oversized molded rigging troughs and ABS backing plates simplify servicing and ensure secure hardware mounting. In house fabricated aluminum framework is sandblasted and powder coated with premium marine finishes, wire harnesses are assembled to marine grade standards with circuit protection by breakers or fuses, and corrosion resistant details—heavy duty rub rail with 316 stainless insert and end caps, 316 cast stainless and chrome plated fasteners, meticulously bedded or gasketed hardware—protect the boat in saltwater environments. Heavy duty welded bow and stern eyes are sealed in polyurethane, and bronze high speed intake strainers complete a build that balances ruggedness with refinement.

Baby Seal suits the owner who seeks a premium center console capable of wearing many hats—offshore sportfisher, family cruiser, and sophisticated dayboat—all wrapped in an elegant 36 foot package. With indoor kept

pedigree, custom finishes, a cutting edge helm, and Everglades' hallmark ride and safety, she presents a rare opportunity in the center console and offshore sportfishing markets. Step aboard for a private inspection and you will see why this yacht still feels as fresh as the day she was delivered.

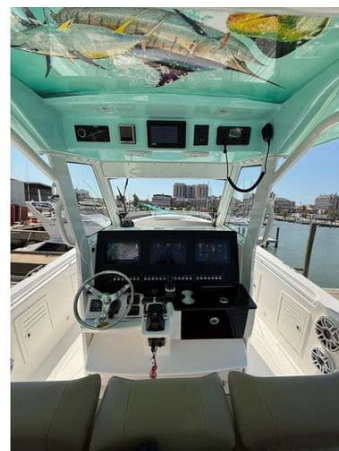
