Located in Key Biscayne, FL, she is offered for private viewing.

The captain commands from a raised helm while guests take in sweeping vistas from generous flybridge seating, enjoying a level of comfort and refinement that blends the best of flybridge cruiser luxury and sport cruiser performance. # DETAILED DESCRIPTION

## Description

---

Meet Deep Blue, the cleanest 36 Sedan Bridge on the market—diesel-powered on straight shafts with only 435 hours on twin Cummins QSB 5.9 engines rated at 380 hp each. Kept in immaculate condition, she has spent the majority of her life in storage, with all service up to date and records available upon request. Lying in Key Biscayne, Florida, she is ready for your private showing. Every element of this beauty is tailored for extended cruising, from her superb ride and sea-keeping to the light-filled salon and two well-appointed staterooms. While the captain commands from the helm, guests take in panoramic views from the generous bridge seating. In comfort and in style, the 36 Sedan Bridge delivers you effortlessly to your destination.

## Other details

---

At the helm, navigation and control are intuitive and redundant, featuring a Raymarine E120 GOS display paired with the Raymarine ST8002 SmartPilot Autohelm Series autopilot, SmartCraft VesselView for engine monitoring, a Side Power bow thruster for precise low-speed handling, a Ritchie compass for traditional reference, an ACR Point Pad URP-102 spotlight for confident night operations, and a Northstar NS100 VHF to keep you connected. The flybridge is fully enclosed in clear Eisenglass for all-weather comfort and fitted with two adjustable, rotating Barelick captain's seats for perfect posture underway. Guests relax on the aft L-shaped lounge with stainless-steel cupholders, protected by an extended Bimini top and secured by an aft stainless railing. An insert transforms the L-shaped seating into a convivial dining nook, laid over snap-on grey Sea Ray carpet. Sound flows crisply through two JL Audio speakers complemented by a Clarion subwoofer, with overhead and cockpit

blue lights setting the mood after sunset. In the cockpit, blue illumination pairs with Attwood lights for safe, stylish evenings, a forward-facing transom bench maximizes conversation at anchor, and a Raritan ice maker keeps beverages perfectly chilled. Step into the salon through a fully enclosed sliding door with an additional sliding blind for privacy. Entertainment is centered around a 30" adjustable Vizio TV above an integrated console, with a Clarion CMD5 stereo, a Clarion DCZ65 6-disc CD changer, an Iwin DVD player, and Glomex TV antenna gain control. Premium Sea Ray lighting controls and a cabin/cockpit stereo switch tailor the ambiance, while a breaker panel with touchscreen simplifies onboard systems. To starboard, a premium-height couch converts into a comfortable berth, matched by a coordinating ottoman, and the forward dining area offers a fold-out table and adjustable sliding seats. Storage is thoughtfully hidden beneath the steps that lead to the galley, where a granite countertop meets a Panasonic Inverter microwave, a Kenyon Euro Kera electric induction stove, a stainless-steel GROHE faucet, and a large sink. Cold storage is generous, with a large upgraded Dometic NRX1115 fridge plus a Dometic NRX1060 fridge with a sectional freezer. Convenient access to the head is provided from the galley, and a hidden sliding door quietly closes off the master for complete privacy. The master stateroom features a large berth for two, adjustable reading lights, a sky porthole with blind, privacy curtains, ample cabinet storage, and direct access to the head. The starboard guest stateroom offers twin single berths for two, adjustable reading lights, privacy curtains, abundant cabinetry, access to the head, and the option to add a filler cushion to create a full-size berth. In the machinery space, a Cummins Onan MDK BK-4555C 6 kW diesel generator shows 450 hours, while the twin Cummins QSB 5.9 HO mains each show 435 hours; serials are Port: 46770784 and Stbd: 46886580. ## Propulsion

This yacht is powered by twin 2008 Cummins QSB 5.9 HO inboard diesels, each rated at 380 hp and showing 435 hours. Both engines turn direct-drive shafts for robust, efficient thrust and low-maintenance simplicity. Engine 1: Cummins QSB 5.9 HO, 2008, 380 hp, 435 hours, inboard, direct drive, diesel. ## Specifications

Cruising speed is 22 kn. Length overall is 38.33 ft with a maximum bridge clearance of 18 ft, a maximum draft of 3.33 ft, and a beam of 13 ft. Dry weight is 22,000 lb. The boat is equipped with an electric windlass, carries a deadrise at the transom of 17 degrees, and features a fiberglass hull with a modified-vee shape. Tankage includes 75 gal of fresh water, 300 gal of fuel, and a 35 gal holding tank. Accommodations comprise 2 guest cabins and 1 guest head.

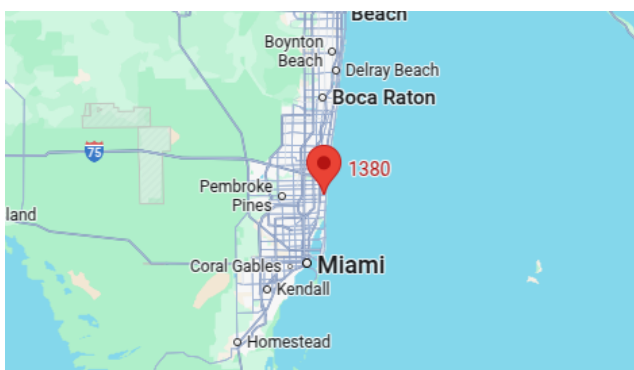
