OVERVIEW

Experience the refined union of performance and comfort aboard the timeless vessel Rough Waters 36 (1985), a 36.5 feet yacht whose graceful lines and dependable construction invite both seasoned mariners and those newly drawn to the sea. Resting now at Hurricane Cove Marina, this 36-foot cruiser—built in 1985 in Tao-Yuan, Taiwan—presents a fiberglass hull crafted to endure, with a breadth of 11.4 feet and a depth of 6.4 feet that balance seakeeping with interior volume, and accommodations that sleep 6 passengers with ease.

Under her decks lie Twin 671 Detroit Turbo engines that have logged 850 engine hours, delivering the power to realize long passages within a range of 725 Nautical Miles. A Westerbeke generator, with just 60 hours, supplies reliable hotel services, while climate comfort is assured by two Dometic air conditioning units. Fuel and water capacity have been thoughtfully modernized: two new 230-gallon diesel tanks with protective covering and two new 150-gallon water tanks extend your cruising autonomy.

Carefully maintained, this yacht benefits from annual hull upkeep, a new shaft and propeller balancing completed last year, and recent mechanical renewals including a new hydraulic helm and steering piston. Twin helm stations provide full control from the flybridge or the living area, making handling both versatile and secure.

Interior spaces are gracious and well-appointed: a master bedroom with an en suite bathroom and an outdoor shower, a complete dining area and kitchen for convivial meals, and a spacious salon with a sofa bed for guests. Practical equipment includes an electric anchor winch, a GPS system, and two VHF radios for navigation and communications.




