OVERVIEW

This 2024 Yellowfin 36, located in Myrtle Beach, SC, is a high performance center console crafted for offshore sportfishing, marrying exhilarating speed with an unusually dry ride and solid, premium construction. Power comes from triple Yamaha 300 XTO outboards with integrated steering that register only 3 hours, and careful climate controlled indoor storage has maintained a near new appearance. With a 10' beam and a 1'8" maximum draft she offers surefooted stability, shallow water access, and effortless handling; the design is fully trailerable and a matching trailer is included—perfect for bluewater passages, coastal cruising, and competitive saltwater tournament fishing.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Console

At the console, a Full Helm Master system anchors the command center, complemented by a precise compass and a Yamaha CL5 display; two stainless steel flush mount cupholders serve the helm while forward rod-cup combination holders add smart utility, and the full liner console is delivered with full fuel and ready to run, presenting a seamlessly integrated control environment that is both purposeful and instantly operational.

Top

The hardtop stands on rear support legs with five rod holders standard, its powdercoated framework sculpted with fingergrrips on the pipework; Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases lie in wait while a pair of heavy duty rod holders extends your reach, and illumination is precisely tuned by a pair of hardtop running lights, five LED spreader lights, and two multi color LED lights that bathe cockpit and helm in perfectly balanced light.

Fishing accessory

Angling amenities abound: a transom livewell window keeps bait in view with eight rodholder cupholder combination mounts distributed for action; a robust Garelick boarding ladder and a pair of transom grab rails simplify reboarding, while two Hubbell 30A electric reel outlets power your deep drop arsenal and fourteen titanium rod holders stand ready; a bilge light enhances serviceability, and fishbox pumpouts—macerator and diaphragm—make cleanouts swift and efficient.

Seating

Forward seating without backrests opens the bow for fishing, while the coffin box adds massive storage complemented by a dedicated coffin box backrest; a five drawer tackle station in Plano style keeps gear orderly, a foldout trash can tucks away neatly, and the large leaning post integrates four cupholders for comfort on the move, delivering a thoughtful balance of angling freedom and organized stowage.

Upholstery

Yellowfin helm seating anchors a cockpit trimmed in a two tone interior with GT boxing, culminating in a Standard Deluxe interior finish that balances durability and elegance, ensuring the tactile comfort of premium seating is matched by refined, resilient surfaces throughout the helm area.

Enhancement and convenience

Everyday ease is engineered in: an electric anchor puller in drum style (no anchor) works alongside a stainless steel plow with 475' of rope and 20' of chain for the windlass, while a bow thruster tightens low speed control; the transom door is glazed for visibility, nightlife glows with two Shadowcaster multi color underwater lights and compartment courtesy lighting, a SeaLand head adds comfort, and systems are bolstered by a four bank pro charging system with an extra Group 31 house battery and two hose coil holders; freshwater and saltwater washdowns stand at the ready, a forward liner anchor access door streamlines ground tackle handling, and a miscellaneous eight switch pre labeled panel keeps command intuitive.

Color

A two tone hull color sets a confident profile on the horizon, framing the boat in a composed and maritime silhouette that reads as both purposeful and stylish from every angle.

Cover, shade, oceangrip

A three plus two panel polycarbonate enclosure with wings cocoons the helm in crisp, clear protection while preserving sightlines, the multi panel arrangement providing weather protection and shelter without sacrificing the panoramic visibility essential for both transit and angling.

Custom work

Custom rigging includes a Rhodan 96' trolling motor paired with a 36V lithium ion battery for silent, pinpoint boat control, a bespoke propulsion solution that elevates maneuverability and stealth for the most exacting anglers.

Trailer

Delivered with a 36YF Ameratrail aluminum trailer that matches the boat's stature with effortless, corrosion resistant transport, the package ensures confident overland movement and long term durability without compromise.

Electronics

An integrated electronics suite centers on a Full Helm Master with two Garmin 8617 MFD GPS displays, a Garmin GSD26 sounder module feeding an Airmar B275LHW 1KW BB transducer, and a Garmin GMR 424 xHD2 open array radar;

stay ahead of systems and storms with the Garmin GXM 54 SiriusXM weather module and a Garmin card reader, and communicate via Garmin VHF 215 and Garmin VHF 215 AIS. Entertainment is powered by a Fusion WB670 stereo with a Fusion ERX 400 wired remote, eight JL Audio 7.7 coaxial speakers, four JL Audio 10" subwoofers, and two JL Audio Mv1000/5i amplifiers, while security and awareness are elevated with Gost NavTracker 1.0 GPS tracking and FLIR MD 625 thermal imaging (no joystick), and a Rokk charger keeps devices topped up for every outing.
