# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Highlights and features

---

This stunning two-tone Ice Blue/Matterhorn White hull 2023 36' Yellowfin is a genuine head-turner, lavishly optioned with \$80,000 in upgrades that elevate both comfort and capability. Notable amenities include forward-facing seating in the bow, a coffin box with an upholstered backrest for relaxed lounging, an upscale double-diamond stitching package, an electric anchor windlass, and a bow thruster for precise low-speed maneuvering. She is virtually new with only 175 engine hours and benefits from an extended warranty that remains in effect through 2027, making this Yellowfin an exceptional blend of like-new condition and purposeful outfitting.

## Equipment and options

---

Purpose-built hardware elevates every moment aboard, beginning with a bow thruster, a Sealand head, and an electric anchor windlass that make anchoring and close-quarters handling effortless. Practical conveniences include hose coil holders and both freshwater and saltwater washdowns to keep the deck pristine, a 4 Bank Pro charging system with an extra house battery for dependable power management, Shadowcaster Blue underwater lights for extended evening enjoyment, and compartment courtesy lights for safe access below. Ground tackle inspires confidence with a stainless-steel plow anchor, 475' of rope, and a 20" chain dedicated to the windlass, while a forward liner anchor access door and a versatile eight-switch pre-labeled panel ensure critical systems and anchoring functions are immediately accessible.

## Electronics and navigation

---

The helm is defined by integrated performance and situational awareness, anchored by two Garmin GPSMAP 8617 multifunction displays that present navigation and charting with clarity. A Garmin GSD26 sounder module pairs with an Airmar B265LH 1KW BB transducer to deliver precise sonar returns, while a Garmin GMR 434 xHD3 radar enhances long-range detection and safety. Autopilot control is handled by a Garmin GHP 40w with GHC 20 controller for steady course-keeping, and connectivity is boosted by a Garmin GXM 54 SiriusXM weather module alongside a Garmin VHF 316 with RAM Mic to maintain communication. Onboard entertainment is robust, driven by a Fusion WB675 stereo that powers six JL Audio 7.7 coaxial speakers, two JL Audio 10" sub-woofers, and two JL Audio amplifiers, and vessel security is reinforced with a GOST Nav-Tracker 2.0.

## Fishing gear

---

Designed for serious anglers, the cockpit is organized to keep tackle and spreads ready at a moment's notice, featuring fourteen titanium rod holders and eighteen rod holder and cup holder combinations that secure rods and convenience items alike. A transom grab rail and a bright livewell light enhance safety and visibility around the stern, while Marinco 30A electric reel outlets provide dependable power for heavy-duty electric reels. Smart storage is provided by a midship storage box (Rowan Box), and a transom livewell window offers a clear view to monitor bait and fish activity without unnecessary disturbance.

## Helm station / console

---

Protection and control converge at the helm where a helm dodger creates a

three-quarter enclosure around the station to shield the skipper and instruments, supported by a precise marine compass and two stainless flush cup holders for convenience. Two forward rod-and-cup combinations are positioned within easy reach for rapid deployment, the full-liner console presents a clean, durable finish for years of service, and engine performance and diagnostics are displayed clearly on the Mercury VesselView 703 screen for immediate and confident monitoring.

## Top

---

The robust hardtop with rear support legs anchors the superstructure and integrates functional lighting and offshore hardware, including hardtop running lights, LED spreader lights, and LED multi-color lights that allow you to set both work-focused illumination and evening ambiance. Offshore-ready equipment includes Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases and a Gemlux 22' internal black outrigger for serious trolling capability, while the powdercoated hardtop framework and substantial hardtop grab rails deliver lasting durability and confident handholds underway.

## Seating and upholstery

---

Comfort aboard is comprehensive and thoughtfully executed, beginning with a new two-piece full mooring cover that protects the entire vessel while in storage or at the dock. The generous helm area is appointed with a large leaning post featuring integrated cup holders and a tackle station with three open drawers for rapid organization. Forward seating is roomy and complemented by a coffin box with an upholstered backrest for relaxed lounging, and the standard deluxe interior is elevated by the double-diamond stitching package and purpose-built Yellowfin helm seating engineered for ergonomic support on long runs.
