OVERVIEW

Introducing the 2023 Aquila 36 Sport, a pristine and unusually spacious power catamaran that marries contemporary lines with spirited performance and understated luxury. Propelled by twin Mercury Verado 400 outboards with approximately 300 hours on the clocks, she cruises effortlessly above 30 knots and will surge past 40 knots at full throttle, and an extended warranty remains in effect. Below deck the 36 Sport offers two generous staterooms and two separate heads, providing a serene, private refuge for extended cruising. This example is heavily optioned and stands among the most comprehensively specified Aquila 36s to leave the factory, with all maintenance completed and current. Whether entertaining a lively gathering or slipping away for a peaceful day on the water, she combines refinement with capability—an exceptional power catamaran and versatile motor yacht, equally suited as a sport cruiser, express cruiser dayboat-weekender, or coastal cruiser—and is available for viewings now.

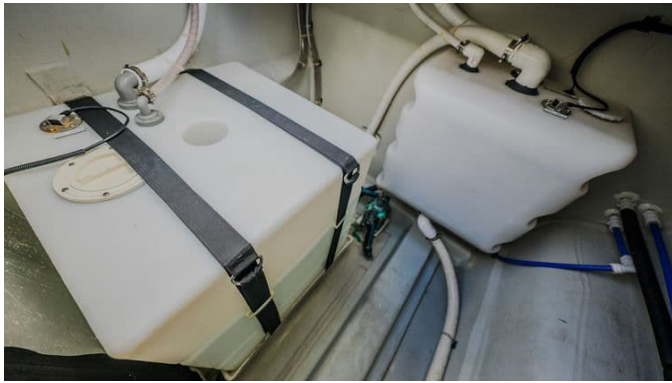
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Additional information

From the first step on deck, the layout reveals a yacht designed for convivial days on the water and effortless movement fore and aft, where the forward cockpit seating comfortably accommodates eight guests and quickly converts into two expansive sunbeds for indulgent lounging. The helm station sits to starboard with deeply cushioned seating for two, mirrored to port by passenger seating aligned with the helm for two more, while a portside settee with a folding table invites relaxed dining and a versatile seating module transforms into a sunbed oriented either forward or aft to suit the mood; additional seating to port and starboard runs along the outboard sides and faces forward, creating a generous social arena underway or at anchor. Practicality is built in everywhere: the entire aft deck is self-draining with additional forward scuppers to keep the decks dry, robust side boarding doors to port and starboard engineered with heavy-duty hardware ensure secure embarkation, and a gate opens to the large aft swim platform for easy access to the water, with an opening windscreen paired with a lower door providing an intuitive, weather-sheltered pass-through to the forward seating. Above, an integrated Targa arch and hardtop frame the space with poise, punctuated by two opening deck hatches, while an optional electric sunroof floods the cockpit with sky at the touch of a switch. The starboard-side galley is a study in refined utility anchored by a Corian countertop and supported by an 80 L fridge/freezer with approximately two point eight cubic feet of capacity, integrated storage compartments, a wash basin, and conveniently placed AC power sockets. Throughout the interior, wood furniture in plywood with a light wood composite laminate finish sets a warm, contemporary tone, synthetic wear-resistant flooring delivers a natural look with low maintenance, and

upholstered side and ceiling panels elevate acoustic comfort; storage shelves, lockers, and drawers are thoughtfully distributed, blinds are fitted to every window, and illumination comes from LED overhead and reading lights with AC power sockets placed throughout for seamless living aboard. Stowage and service access are comprehensive and cleverly hidden, with an insulated cooler with an integrated drain built into the port seating, storage lockers beneath all aft seating, forward hull lockers accessed from under the forward seats, and an additional locker beneath the forward seating floor area; large aft hatches grant straightforward equipment access, the anchor locker benefits from a separate chain locker, and the swim platform hatch offers optional ladder access for confident reboarding, with all large hatches assisted by gas lifts for fingertip operation and every cabin protected by a carbon monoxide alarm. Underpinning it all is robust construction and premium deck hardware: railings and handholds are crafted in AISI 316 stainless steel and complemented by a custom PVC rub rail with a 316 stainless insert for full perimeter protection, a tempered glass windscreen with a custom aluminum frame is cleared by two variable speed wipers, and the bow is equipped with a 316 stainless steel anchor platform and roller; ten pop up mooring cleats in polished 316 stainless steel are through bolted for absolute security, and 316 stainless steel deck fill plates serve water, fuel, and waste systems, while safety and visibility are assured with an emergency ladder and LED navigation lights for port, starboard, anchor, and running duties. Convenience features include integrated side boarding gates with robust stainless hardware and LED drink holders—four in the forward cockpit and six in the salon area—alongside a 30 A shore power connection, ambient LED overhead lighting enriching the hardtop, settee, and galley areas, and an audio system with speakers in the forward seating and cabins that brings the soundtrack to every space. Accommodation is bright, quiet, and restorative, with each cabin offering double V berths topped with memory foam mattresses and framed by wood furniture with a composite laminate finish; large hull windows flood the spaces

with natural light and fresh air, augmented by deck hatches above the cabins for additional airflow and brightness, while blinds on all windows and carbon monoxide alarms in every cabin ensure privacy and peace of mind, with LED reading lights and overhead lighting completing a serene, energy efficient ambience. The electrical system is designed for authority and simplicity, centered on a master 12 V control panel with remote battery master switches positioned at the companionway, an engine parallel control and shore power management system that adds confidence offshore and convenience in port, and power reserves delivered by two dedicated engine start batteries AGM 200 Ah each and one house battery AGM 200 Ah with an optional second house battery for extended autonomy; a 120/3000 VA inverter/charger manages seamless AC conversion and charging, supported by volt and amp meters, a digital tank monitoring system for water and waste, a galvanic isolator system, and a reverse polarity indicator, while entertainment is orchestrated by a multi zone master unit so every area can enjoy its own perfect mood. Fuel and engine bay systems emphasize safety, range, and control, with fully independent manual fuel shut off valves for maintenance and emergencies, aluminum fuel tanks totaling 1,350 L with a gauge providing substantial cruising autonomy, tank vents and natural ventilation complemented by forced ventilation governed from the helm station, filtration entrusted to Mercury fuel filters, and the engine space protected by an automatic fire suppression system with alarm monitoring at the helm plus a fuel tank area alarm system integrated at the helm for instant awareness.

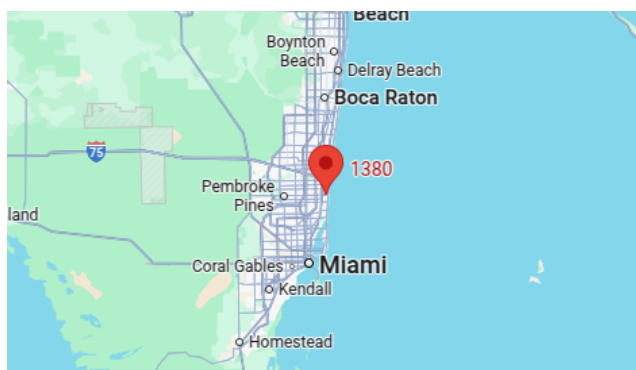
