Designed for the discerning big-game angler, the 2026 37 Onslow Bay Tournament Edition is a striking center console that reaches the fishing grounds with authority, exceeding 70 mph on three Mercury V10 outboards rated at 400 HP each and covered by warranty through 01/2033. Purpose-built for true bluewater sportfishing, she is equipped with a folding tower, a comprehensive Garmin navigation suite, a fully self-bailing deck, five insulated fishboxes and two livewells. Offered in outstanding condition with low hours, this 2026 model presents a rare chance to own a tournament-ready Onslow Bay that harmonizes long-range capability and exhilarating performance with refined comfort and elegant style.

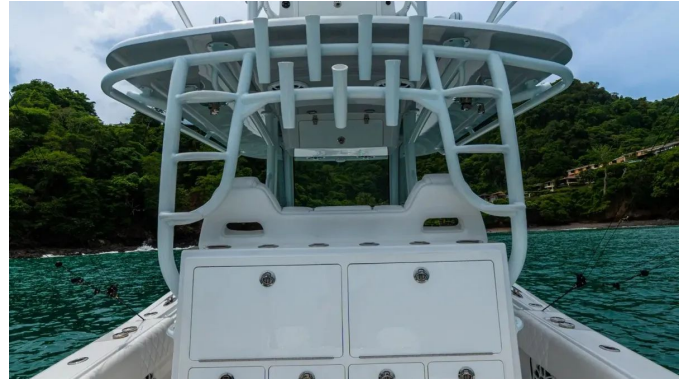

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Hull

---

The hull is engineered around a positive-lift, ventilated step design, beginning with a 48-degree entry and a 24-degree deadrise, complemented by 7-degree reverse chines and a generous flare to produce an exceptionally dry, confident ride. A transom notch is provided to accept recessed trim tabs, while Mercury Racing K-Plane trim tabs, sized 14 by 30 inches, deliver fine-tuned attitude control. Construction is uncompromisingly premium: the structure is entirely foam-core with no wood and no risk of rot, built throughout with Vinyl Ester resin-infused construction. Structural joints are bonded using Plexus specialty adhesives rather than polyester putty, and all compartments except the bilge and fish boxes are foam-filled to increase stiffness and acoustic quietness. Three fuel tanks, foamed and fiberglassed into place for added strength and security, total 540 gallons. Bilge management comprises two Rule 2000 gph bilge pumps with internal float switches, augmented by a forward Rule 800 gph pump. An Accon Marine stainless steel pop-up bow light provides low-profile reliability, and deck hardware is finished with six Accon Marine 10-inch pop-up stainless steel cleats and two Accon Marine 8-inch pop-up stainless steel cleats to ensure secure, streamlined mooring.

## Console

---

Crowned by an aluminum powder-coated T-top beneath an elegant fiberglass hardtop, the console is thoughtfully appointed with integrated LED spreader lighting, rod holders and an electronics box, while a three-sided laminated glass windshield provides refined protection for the helm. Inside the console cabin there is six feet six inches of headroom and a comfortable berth that measures 49 inches long by 39 inches wide, complemented by a fitted

countertop and sink and a full-sized, plumbed head. A leaning-post tackle center with a slide-out Frigid Rigid cooler completes this meticulously arranged space, marrying practical angling features with luxurious comfort.

## Fishing equipment

---

A fully integrated Sea Chest system underpins a fishing outfitting designed to perform when it matters most, supplying a 68-gallon split round transom livewell finished in Carolina Blue and capped with a clear plexiglass lid, together with a 59-gallon split round floor livewell located forward of the console. Cold storage is substantial and thoughtfully distributed: an insulated 800-quart front fish box measuring 68"L x 37"W x 21"D anchors the arrangement, while two insulated 300-quart side fish boxes amidships at 65"L x 18"W x 15"D and two insulated 230-quart side fish boxes in the cockpit at 62"L x 18"W x 12"D provide additional capacity, and a 160-quart cooler is cleverly stowed beneath the lounge seat on the forward face of the console. Tackle readiness is effortless with four 30° screwless gunnel-mount stainless steel rod holders along the rails and eight 0° screwless stainless steel rod holders integrated into the lounge seat, while sightlines and operational flexibility are elevated by a tower with helm. A one-level deck with a gutter drainage system ensures secure footing and easy movement in all conditions, and the fisherman-friendly three-piece hull, cap, and liner construction blends rugged practicality with refined execution.

## Helm

---

Seated in Llebroc helm chairs, the captain oversees a fully appointed suite of Garmin electronics while a Ritchie flush-mount compass set into the dash delivers precise heading information. A Duradek console top pad incorporates two flush phone chargers for discreet, convenient power, and a Starboard

flush-mount electronics cabinet with a clear hideaway door shields critical instrumentation while keeping it immediately at hand.

## **Mechanical / electrical**

---

A heavy-duty shore power and battery-charging system provides dependable onboard energy management. Each hatch is appointed with stainless-steel piano hinges and premium Gemlux® hardware, securing tightly with 2.5" stainless-steel compression latches. All doors are fashioned from King Starboard®, back-screwed for a clean, refined appearance, and are fitted with Gemlux® stainless-steel slam latches.

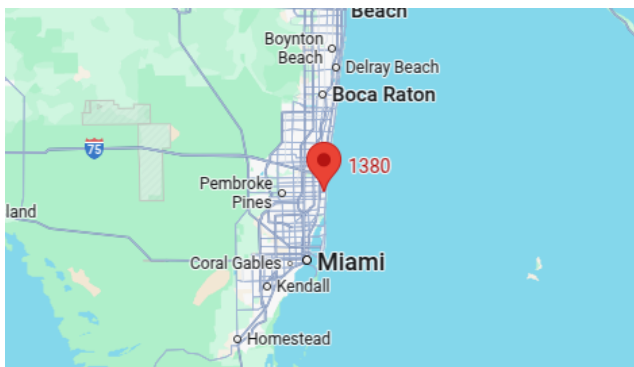
