The 1996 Wellcraft Scarab 37 presents a striking profile, its lines promising both drama and grace as twin MerCruiser 8.2L MPI engines propel the hull with a combined 1,400 HP. Measuring 37 feet overall with an 8 foot beam, this high-performance powerboat — equally an offshore sport cruiser and a go-fast boat — is engineered for full-throttle escapades while retaining confident, responsive handling.

Onboard electronics include GPS, radar and a depth sounder, complemented by a premium sound system that keeps the voyage connected and entertaining. Below decks a tasteful cuddy cabin offers a guest berth and a private head for overnight comfort, and a road trailer simplifies overland transport. As a dayboat for relaxed cruising or a brisk sport-fishing platform, this offshore powerboat marries style, speed and versatility.

Step aboard the 37 Wellcraft Scarab and you are welcomed by a spacious, open cockpit where performance and comfort are perfectly balanced, the helm presenting a well-equipped dash that brings navigation and vessel intelligence to your fingertips with GPS, radar and a depthsounder while a quality sound system keeps every run entertaining. Twin MerCruiser 8.2L MPI engines deliver a thrilling 1,400 HP that unlocks brisk cruising speeds and confident offshore passages, and forward the bow offers generous seating designed for relaxed underway comfort while a guest cabin accessed through the console, complete with guest heads, provides a cozy overnight retreat. The cockpit is equally adept at action and leisure, offering ample room for fishing gear or sunbathing, and a road trailer extends your range with effortless transport, making the 37 Wellcraft Scarab a compelling synthesis of power, performance and comfort for seekers of waterborne adventure.

## Electronics

---

At the helm the electronics suite has been thoughtfully curated to inspire confidence and clarity, with a depthsounder that reads the bottom with precision, a reliable compass that complements GPS navigation and radar awareness, and onboard entertainment provided by a DVD player, radio and CD player driving crisp cockpit speakers so that every voyage is both safe and enjoyable.

## Inside equipment

---

Onboard comfort is elevated by hatchway air conditioning that keeps the

interior cool and inviting, creating a pleasant refuge after sunlit hours, while a microwave oven adds everyday convenience for quick meals and refreshments so you can extend your time on the water without sacrificing simple comforts.

## Covers

---

Protection and shade are provided by a bimini top that shelters the cockpit when desired, while additional care for the boat when not underway is assured by a mainsail cover, a cockpit cover and a genoa cover, each contributing to long-term preservation and readiness.

## Additional equipment

---

Rounding out its versatility, a road trailer accompanies the boat, simplifying transport and expanding your cruising grounds by allowing effortless overland movement to new launch points and adventurous destinations.
